
## Sidewalk Closure on Mill Street between Bayview Avenue and Tannery Road

**Expected start date and duration:** Monday, July 22, 2024, for approximately ten months



## What is happening?

- As early as Monday, July 22, 2024, the sidewalk on the south side of Mill Street will be closed between Bayview Avenue and Tannery Road for approximately ten months to safely complete construction work in the Don Yard rail corridor.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the north side of Mill Street see map above for pedestrian routes and closures.

## Traffic and pedestrian details

- The sidewalk on the south side of Mill Street will be closed between Bayview Avenue and Tannery Road.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Mill Street will remain open for pedestrians.
- Trucks will use the two access points on the south side of Mill Street to enter and exit the site
- Advance signage and safety barriers will be in place to guide pedestrians, drivers, and cyclists.
- Traffic control personnel will be stationed at the site access points to direct vehicles and pedestrians.
- Increased truck traffic on Mill Street can be expected.

## **About the Ontario Line**
