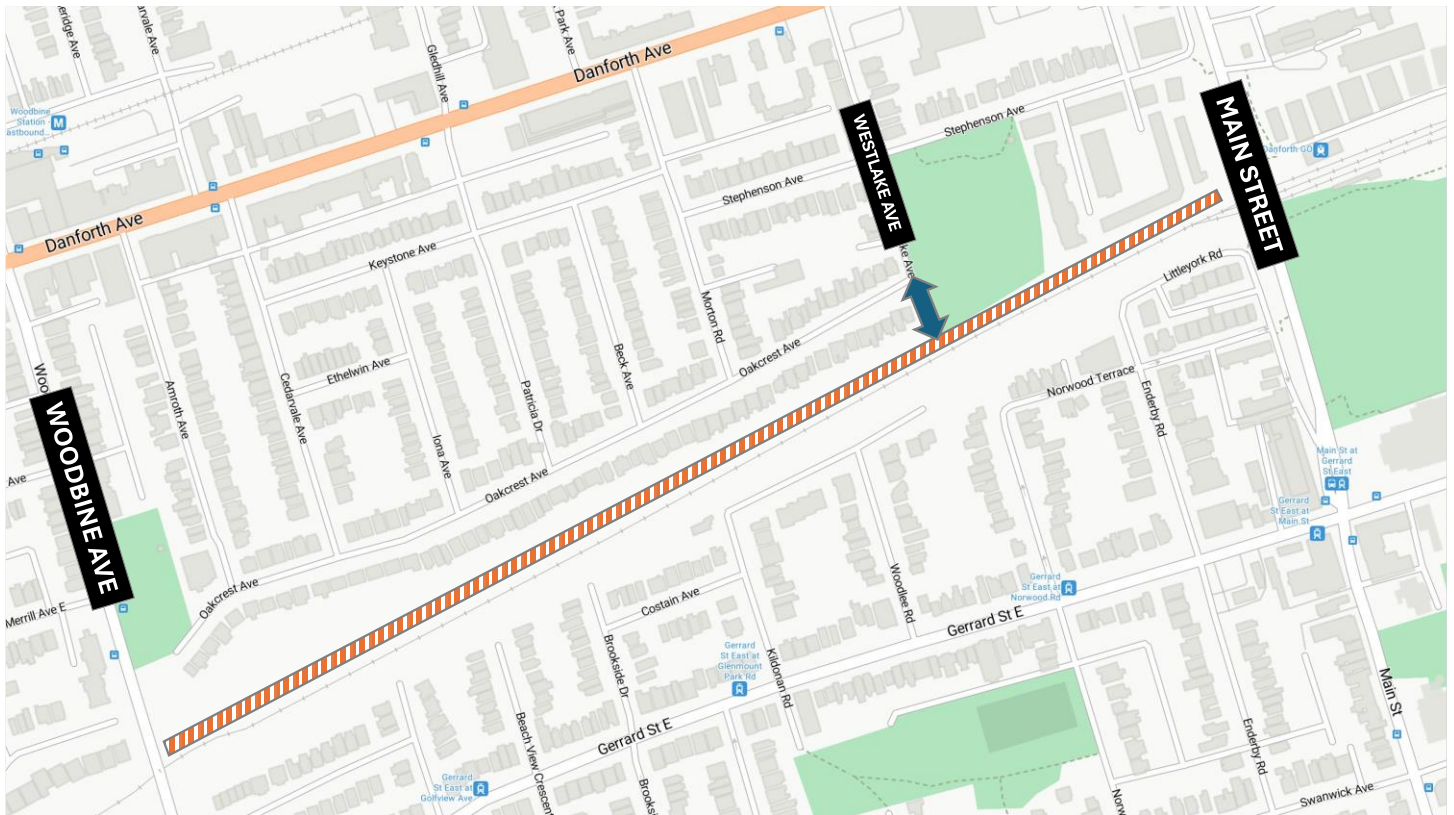


Night works between Woodbine Ave and Main St

Project Overview

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. To enable this improved service, we are getting ready to build an additional railway track and for the future electrification of the route.

We need to carry out final grading and sub-ballast works to the north of the railway corridor between Woodbine Avenue and Main Street (shown in orange above). To keep our crews safe, this work must be carried out at night when there are no trains running along the Lakeshore East rail corridor.

What Work is Taking Place?

Work durations are approximate, work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Local residents should expect some noise, dust and an increase in construction activities and traffic at night. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Our construction crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:

- Reduced idling of non-essential equipment
- Limiting of reversing operations where possible.
- Use of white noise back up alarms where possible.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

There are no pedestrian impacts associated with these works and sidewalks will remain open.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

Roads will remain open but there will be an increase in the number of construction vehicles on local roads. We ask local communities to be vigilant of the increase in traffic.

The worksite shown on the graphic overleaf will be access via Westlake Ave.
