### OVERVIEW:

On Wednesday, June 26, 2024, Metrolinx hosted a virtual CLC meeting for Osgoode, in partnership with Ontario Transit Group (OTG). Metrolinx and OTG provided a construction update on construction, including York Street trackwork as well as Ontario Line construction progress.

During the session, attendees asked questions related to construction, including monitoring devices, community artwork and hoarding.

**QUESTIONS:**

- **Queen West BIA** asked if Osgoode South hoarding could have windows within the hoarding along the pedestrian walkway for safety purposes, similarly to the Queen Spadina hoarding?
  - **OTG** will look into this request and provide an update at the next CLC.
  
- **Campbell House Museum** asked for more context regarding the community artwork program.
  - **OTG** noted a survey will be sent out to provide feedback and share ideas on what each neighbourhood would like to see. While launch dates are to be determined, but will be communicated once finalized.
  - **Campbell House Museum** asked about the range, location and length of the hoarding available and if that information will be provided in the survey.
  - **OTG** noted the survey will be the same across the alignment, with a question asking respondents to identify their neighbourhood. The survey is not planned to include details about what specific areas of hoarding will house artwork, but will rather focus on gathering community feedback on what each community would like to see reflected in the artwork designs selected.
  - **Campbell House Museum** asked about how OTG and Metrolinx will choose an artist.
  - **Metrolinx** replied, noting that decisions will be made depending on the results from the survey. **OTG** agreed and stated the intent is to listen to the community first.
  - **Campbell House Museum** recommended Metrolinx should provide the community with specific details about the available areas for artwork, with options to choose from to get the best feedback. They also suggested providing the opportunity to rank categories.
  - **Metrolinx** thanked **Campbell House Museum** for the comments.
  
- **Campbell House Museum** asked for clarity on monitoring devices, such as, are they all the same and how will they be installed?
  - **OTG** noted devices can be different depending on their task, and that locations are determined based on the risks assessed for that location.
  - **Campbell House Museum** requested more details to be shared before the devices start being placed, including information about the size and placement of monitors.
  - **OTG** noted some devices may stay at surface level, but others may require drilling into the ground and the device to be placed within the hole.
  
- **Bell Media** asked will there be a pre-construction survey inspection and who is coordinating this work with the asset owners?
  - **Metrolinx** replied there have been a series of PTE surveys, and suggest emailing the Metrolinx Community Engagement team about this specific request.
  
- **TTC representative** asked if there was anyone from TTC or subway infrastructure on the call.

- **Metrolinx** noted that the focus of this CLC series is the Ontario Line subway, and that the TTC does not usually participate in these meetings, although they do coordinate with them.

**ACTIONS:**

- **OTG** to provide updated on Osgoode South hoarding design, specific to the pedestrian walkway.
- **OTG and Metrolinx** to share information about monitoring devices.
