Bus loop and car park work at Confederation Station

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology and more connections. The new Confederation GO Station is part of that expansion. Our goal is to deliver more than 10,000 train trips a week across the entire network. You won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

Starting July 29, construction crews will be working within the bus loop and parking lot to install bollards (posts to separate the road from the pedestrian areas), CCTV equipment and communications equipment e.g. conduits and cables. Temporary bus stops and sidewalks will be available. More information can be found on the next page.

Phase 1 - Work on the west side of the bus loop to install temporary bus stops (x4) and sidewalks	Starting July 29, 2024 for approximately 2 weeks	Monday-Friday: 7am-5pm Daytime	Work will involve placing new signage for temporary bus stops and ensuring pedestrian routes are accessible.
Phase 2 - Work on the east side of the bus loop to the parking lot and pedestrian walkways	Starting August 12, 2024 for approximately 4 weeks		Work will involve concrete cutting which could create some dust. Therefore, the site is sectioned off from the existing publicly accessible areas.
Please note, dates and durations are approximate and may change.			

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Visitors to the area should expect some noise, vibration and dust.
- Crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows
 - A safely secured work area.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- No roads will be closed.
- Approximately 16 parking spaces will remain along the north portion of the existing parking lot. Please note, most of these will be reserved as accessible parking spaces.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no pedestrian sidewalk closures planned.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.
