King Liberty GO:Vegetation Removal on Sudbury Street




Figure 1:The approx. location of retaining wall where vegetation will be removed.

What Is Happening

As part of early works for the future SmartTrack King Liberty GO station, crews will be removing vegetation along a retaining wall on the south side of Sudbury Street at Abell Street. To build the transit system of the future, vegetation often needs to be pruned or removed to make room for new transit infrastructure. Trees removed as part of this project will be compensated for through Metrolinx's Vegetation program based on the Metrolinx Vegetation Guideline (2022). Project Overview

SmartTrack is bringing five new GO stations to Toronto, leveraging roughly 40 km of Metrolinx's preexisting GO rail corridors within Toronto. The program is a collaboration between the Province of Ontario, City of Toronto, and Metrolinx that will transform heavy rail infrastructure in Toronto from a





regional commuter service into an urban rapid transit network. King-Liberty GO Station will be located on the Kitchener line between Union and Bloor GO stations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All required permits have been obtained for the tree removals.
- Trees marked for removal will be safely cut and moved away for wood chipping.
- You may experience noise caused by chainsaws and other equipment.

HOURS OF WORK

- Day work is expected to take place between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- The work will take approximately two (2) days to complete.
- Dates may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

LOCATION OF WORK

 The work will take place on the municipal right of way, on the south side of Sudbury Street, at Abell Street, north of the Kitchener GO Rail Corridor (see Figure 1).

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Sidewalk on the south side of Sudbury will be closed. Please following all detour signs.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please watch for slow-moving construction vehicles and equipment which may be entering/exiting the work zone.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There are no transit impacts at this time.
