

Tree Inventory in the Royal Orchard community

Scheduled Work Period: August 26 - 30, 2024

Timing: 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

What is happening?

Arborists will be working in the area of Yonge Street, Royal Orchard, and Inverlochy Boulevard to document and inventory trees in the Royal Orchard community.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The extension includes five confirmed stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

OVERVIEW

- Arborists will be documenting information including the location, species, size, and condition of trees at select addresses in and around the Royal Orchard community.
- Information about the location and characteristics of trees will be used to inform plans for future construction work related to the new Royal Orchard Station.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work is expected to be completed within two hours but may take longer due to unforeseen circumstances.
- No noise or disruptions are expected.

METHODOLOGY

- An arborist dressed in reflective gear will be conducting the inventory using a handheld GPS receiver to document the precise location of trees.
- There will be no machinery on site.
