# What is happening?

• Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx have begun construction activities at the Mount Dennis station in preparation for the 500-meter tunnel which will connect the extension to the future Eglinton Crosstown LRT service at Mount Dennis Station.

### Hours of work

- Work may be scheduled outside regular work hours, as required.
- Work may be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

## What to expect

- Work will take place in the Mount Dennis Station Plaza, as well as behind the station adjacent to Hollis Street as marked in the map above.
- Over the next few months, the community can expect to see:
  - Tree removals within municipal Right of Way (ROW) and concrete planters
  - o Site grading, installation of fencing around the construction site, and additional traffic signals
- Once complete, utility works will begin, including the relocation of storm sewers ahead of works to support excavation anticipated in late 2024.
- At this time fencing will be moved to the road's edge and the north cycle track will be decommissioned.
- A temporary bi-directional cycle path and pedestrian walkway will be open for use on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West during construction.
- Measures will be taken to minimize disruptions wherever possible.
- As work progresses dates for short-term lane closures will be communicated through on-site signage and posted online in the traffic management plans section on the website.

## About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the future Mount Dennis LRT station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
