

# Replacement of Utility Poles & Cables at Hwy 7 & Eureka St.

(September 3<sup>rd</sup> - October 18<sup>th</sup>, Monday-Thursday 8am-4pm)

## Overview

Metrolinx is continuing to make progress on upgrades to the Stouffville corridor in support of GO Expansion and future electrification. Starting this September, we will be replacing the hydro poles and overhead hydro cables at Hwy 7 & Eureka St.

## What does this mean for you?

- Nearby residents and business owners may experience noise from the radial boom derrick (RBD) truck.
- Westbound traffic on Hwy 7 will be reduced to one lane. Signage will be posted and traffic personnel will present to direct traffic.
- No outages are expected, but a generator will be in place mitigate any impacts if an outage is experienced.

We appreciate your patience while we make the necessary improvements for future expansion on the Stouffville GO Line.
