## **Aurora GO Station Improvements**

As part of the GO Expansion project, improvements are coming to Aurora GO Station. Improvements include constructing a second platform, installing a second track, upgrading rail signals, building a new pedestrian tunnel with elevators, and installing tactile tiles on the existing east platform for improved accessibility.

To support these improvements, Metrolinx contractor **Grascan Construction Ltd** will be undertaking overnight track cutting between Birch Court and Centre Street.

### What is happening?

As part of this work, contractors will be cutting the tracks to install insulated joints at the two locations in the corridor, north of Wellington Street. This installation is in preparation for future track work that will be taking place to support the Aurora GO Station improvements.

# What to expect

Work is being done overnight to safely install the insulated joints while there is no train service. Construction activities will take place from Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> to Thursday, September 5<sup>th</sup> during the hours of 11:00pm - 6:30am.

Nearby residents can expect to experience noise associated with general construction activities and equipment (such as pick-up trucks and boom trucks). Sound monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure noise levels are kept within the municipal noise by-laws. Contractors will ensure lights from equipment are faced away from residential homes to keep light pollution levels as low as possible.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. We understand that we are conducting track work in a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this critical work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
