

# UPDATE: Continuous Weekend Works and Additional Lane Reductions for Track Installation at Burnhamthorpe Road and Hurontario Street

September 6, 2024, at 10 p.m., to September 8, 2024 at 7 a.m.



## What work is taking place?

As part of the process for the track installation as described in the construction notice sent in August, crews will **conduct continuous construction** over two weekends at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Hurontario Street. This work will involve excavation from Friday night into Monday morning. The second weekend is scheduled to take place on **September 6, 2024 at 10pm until September 8, 2024 at 7am**. Traffic restrictions include:

- No right turns onto Burnhamthorpe Road heading southbound from Hurontario Street
- No left turns onto Burnhamthorpe Road heading southbound from Hurontario Street
- No left turns onto Hurontario Street from Burnhamthorpe Road
- No right turns onto Hurontario Street heading eastbound from Burnhamthorpe Road
- No left turns onto Burnhamthorpe Road heading northbound from Hurontario Street
- North-south traffic on Hurontario Street will be reduced to a single lane
- No left-left turns at Absolute Avenue and Hurontario Street
- No left-left turns at Matthews Gate and Hurontario Street

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. ### TIMING

- Continuous weekend works are scheduled from Friday 10pm until Monday 7am on September 6 – September 8, 2024
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Movements will be reduced to a single lane in all directions at Hurontario Street and Burnhamthorpe Road.
- Additional lane and turning restrictions will be in effect during the continuous weekend operations, including at Matthews Gate and Absolute Avenue
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

### PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require property access for this work.
