

Utility Relocations at Water St. & Timothy St.

Schedule: September 30, 2024 until the end of spring 2025

Timing: 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

To support GO Expansion projects, crews will be mobilizing to take overhead utilities and transfer them underground to remove overhead cable conflicts over the Metrolinx Barrie corridor.

WHAT TO EXPECT

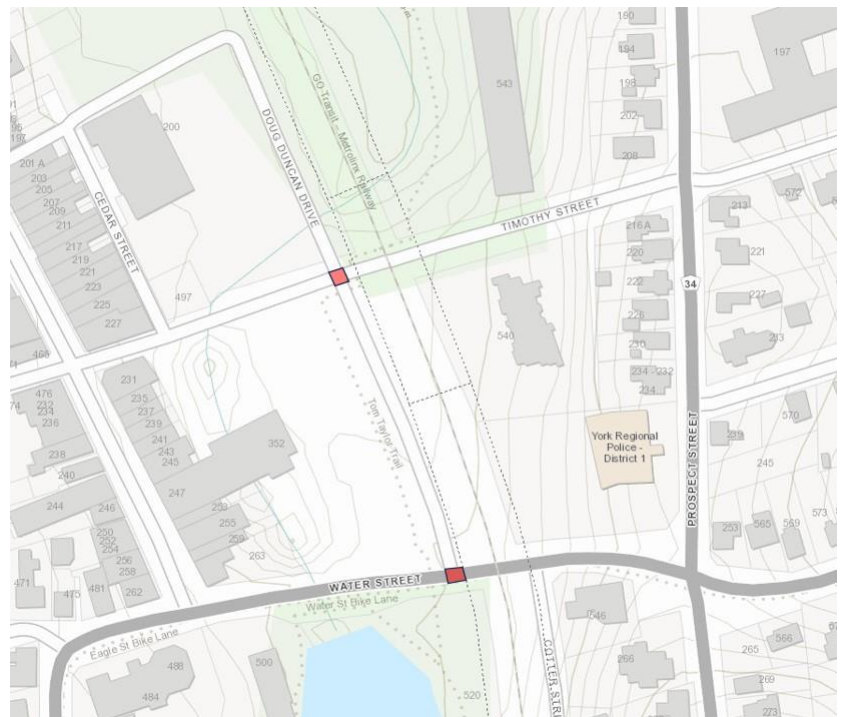
- All work will take place within the city right-of-way.
- Standard construction noise will remain within the allowable municipal by-law limits.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be temporary lane closures on Timothy Street and Water Street.
- The lane closures will begin on Timothy Street in October-November 2024 and will move to Water Street in February-March 2025.
- There will be signage set up to notify residents of the lane closures and detours around the work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- The sidewalk adjacent to the lane closures will also be closed.
- There will be signage set up to notify residents of the sidewalk closures.
- Residents will still be able to access Timothy Street, Water Street and Doug Duncan Drive throughout the construction via the pedestrian crossing on the opposite side.



TRANSIT INFORMATION

- York Region Transit (YRT) will temporarily relocate Bus Stop #2077, located on the north side of Water Street at Doug Duncan Drive to accommodate upcoming work. YRT will post signage in advance of the relocation. Check YRT's website for Service Changes and Updates.
