

13th Line Crossing Rehabilitation - East of Sideroad 20

September 20, 2024 at 11:00p.m. to September 23, 2024 at 4:00a.m.



What is happening?

As a part of the corridor maintenance program, construction will take place at the railway track crossing on 13th Line in Bradford West Gwillimbury, in the Barrie rail corridor, to support infrastructure and corridor maintenance.

What does this mean for you?

From Friday, September 20th to Monday, September 23 2024, Metrolinx contractors will be performing a full railway crossing rehabilitation. They will excavate road asphalt, install new track panels and replace the existing ballast, material which forms the trackbed, with new.

Work will begin on Friday September 20th, 2024 at 11:00p.m. and continue throughout the weekend until Monday September 23, 2024 at 4:00 a.m.

13th Line will be **closed at the track crossing** in order to facilitate the work. The railway will not be affected. Emergency services have been notified however our contractors will provide access across the tracks for emergency vehicles should it be required.

To accommodate individuals who require vehicle access, parking will be available on the 13th Line west of the crossing to 20th Sideroad. A flagman will be in place to ensure pedestrian safety at the railway crossing. Contractors on-site can provide transportation for residents down 13th Line, should it be required.

Nearby residents and businesses may experience noise from the use of construction machinery and equipment required to safely complete this work, including a surfacing tamper and ballast regulator.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. We understand that we are conducting rail maintenance in a populated area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this critical work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
