## Train Signal Installation at Thackeray Street

**Expected start date:** As early as Thursday, September 19, 2024

**Expected duration:** Approximately three weeks


Hours of work: Monday - Saturday from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. with periodic overnight work

## What is happening?

- As early as Thursday, September 19, 2024, work will take place at the north end of Thackeray Street to install new train signals in the rail corridor.
- Most work will take place during the daytime,
   Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. 7 p.m.
- Crews must work overnight to install the new train signals, as this work cannot be done safely when trains are running in the rail corridor during the day.
- Overnight work is expected to take place on Monday September 23 and Tuesday September 24, and on the weekend of Friday October 4 - Sunday October 6, 2024.

## What to expect

- Steel beams and other materials will be delivered to the north end of Thackeray Street
- On the weekend of Friday October 4 Sunday October 6 crews will install the new train signals.
- The Lakeshore East GO Rail Corridor will be shut down starting the night of Friday October
   4 to the morning of Monday October 7 to complete this work.
- A crane will be used to lift the steel beams and signals into place.
- During this work, vehicles and pedestrians will not be able to access the north portion of Thackeray Street.
- Noise and vibration from construction equipment trucks, cranes, loaders, and other heavy machinery can be expected.
- Noise mitigation measures will be implemented as required.
- Clear signage will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians.
- Access to private property will be maintained.



- Traffic barrels, fencing, and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 transit connections, including GO, TTC, and more.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
