
Temporary closure at Centre View Drive ramp from Hurontario Street for roadworks

Beginning Monday September 30, 2024 at 7 a.m to Monday October 7, 2024 at 7 a.m.



Project Overview

The Hazel McCallion Line project will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal.

What You Need to Know

Crews will be doing concrete work at the ramp at Centre View Drive at Hurontario Street. This work is scheduled to begin **Monday September 30, 2024 at 7 a.m.**, **until Monday October 7, 2024 at 7 a.m.** During this work, southbound traffic on Hurontario Street will not be permitted to access the ramp at Centre View Drive. Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained. Motorists can detour via Square One Drive and City Centre Drive. Sidewalk access at Centre View Drive will be closed. Wayfinding signs will guide pedestrians to the nearest intersection to cross safely to the east sidewalk.



Transit services will be impacted by these construction works, including a detour for **Miway Route 7S, 17S and 68S and 315S**. Please visit **www.miway.ca/updates** for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that properties near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- Intersection work is scheduled to begin September 30, 2024, and continue until October 7, 2024.
- Construction is scheduled to take place 24/7.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access from Hurontario Steet onto Centre View Drive will not be permitted.
- Detour route is available via Square One Drive and City Centre Drive.
- Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay Route 7S, 17S, and 68S and 315S will be detoured.
- Visit MiWay.ca for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access at Centre View Drive will be closed.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours are required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

• Crews will not require property access for this work.
