

Borehole drilling on Don Mills Rd from Gateway Blvd to Wynford Dr.

Expected start date: As early as September 30th, 2024

Expected completion date: April 2025

Hours of work: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.



What is happening?

- In preparation for upcoming Ontario Line station and elevated guideway construction, crews will be drilling boreholes along Don Mills Road, from the future Flemington Park station at Don Mills and Overlea and to the future Don Mills and Eglinton station. This includes drilling boreholes in the parking lot of the Ontario Science Centre.
- The drilling will take place within the area indicated above to verify the underlying soil characteristics and to inform the design of the future stations and guideway.
- The work will be contained within the fenced work areas outlined above and will take place starting on September 30th until approximately April 2025. Work will occur between 7 am and 7 pm, Monday to Friday. Lanes of traffic in all directions will be maintained and sidewalks will not be impacted. One exception is described below.

- One borehole will be drilled in the median of Don Mills Rd., approximately in front of the Foresters building with a minimal impact on one North bound and one South bound traffic lanes for a 7 to 10 day period.

What to expect

- The borehole drilling will take place between 7 am and 7 pm, Monday to Friday.
- Some lanes of traffic may be closed with minimal impact to ensure safety, and a minimum of two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained. Sidewalks will remain open.
- For this work a hydro-vac truck and drill-rig will be used. Some noise may be generated by the specified construction equipment and vehicles.
- Construction equipment and materials will be securely kept within work zones.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions or other construction-related impacts.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips on the road each day.
