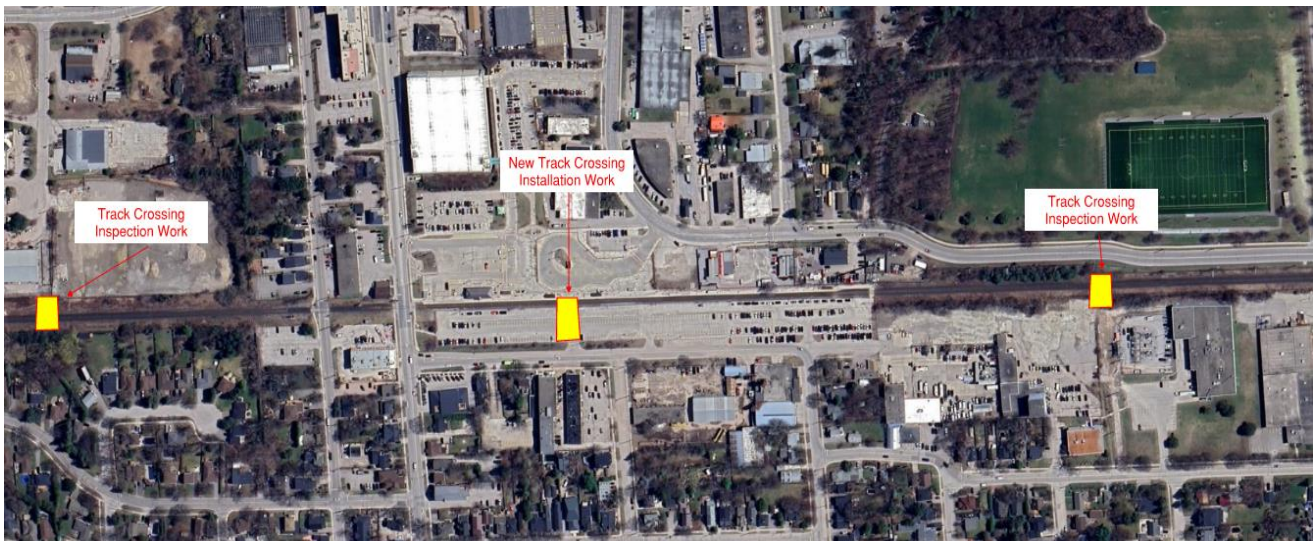


# Overnight Track Maintenance at Aurora GO Station

Schedule: October 11<sup>th</sup> – October 18<sup>th</sup>

Timing: 9:00pm – 5:00am



## Aurora GO Station Improvements

As part of the GO Expansion project, improvements are coming to Aurora GO Station. Improvements include constructing a second platform, installing a second track, upgrading rail signals, building a new pedestrian tunnel with elevators, and installing tactile tiles on the existing east platform for improved accessibility.

To support these improvements, Metrolinx contractor **Grascan Construction Ltd** will undertake overnight track maintenance along the corridor.

## What is happening?

As part of this work, contractors will be installing new wooden planks, track ties, rail anchors and rail plates at three locations in the corridor. This includes locations near the Scanlon Court parking lot, the west parking lot at Aurora GO, and south of the corridor by Cousins Drive. This track maintenance is in preparation for future track work that will be taking place to support the Aurora GO Station improvements.

## **What to expect**

Work is being done overnight while there is no train service to increase safety efforts. Construction activities will take place from October 11<sup>th</sup> to October 18<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Nearby residents can expect to experience noise associated with general construction activities and equipment (such as excavators, loaders, dump trucks, and hand tools). Sound monitoring technology will be utilized near the Scanlon Court working area to ensure that noise and vibration levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.

Contractors will ensure lights from equipment are faced away from residential homes to keep light pollution levels as low as possible.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. We understand that we are conducting track work in a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this critical work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
