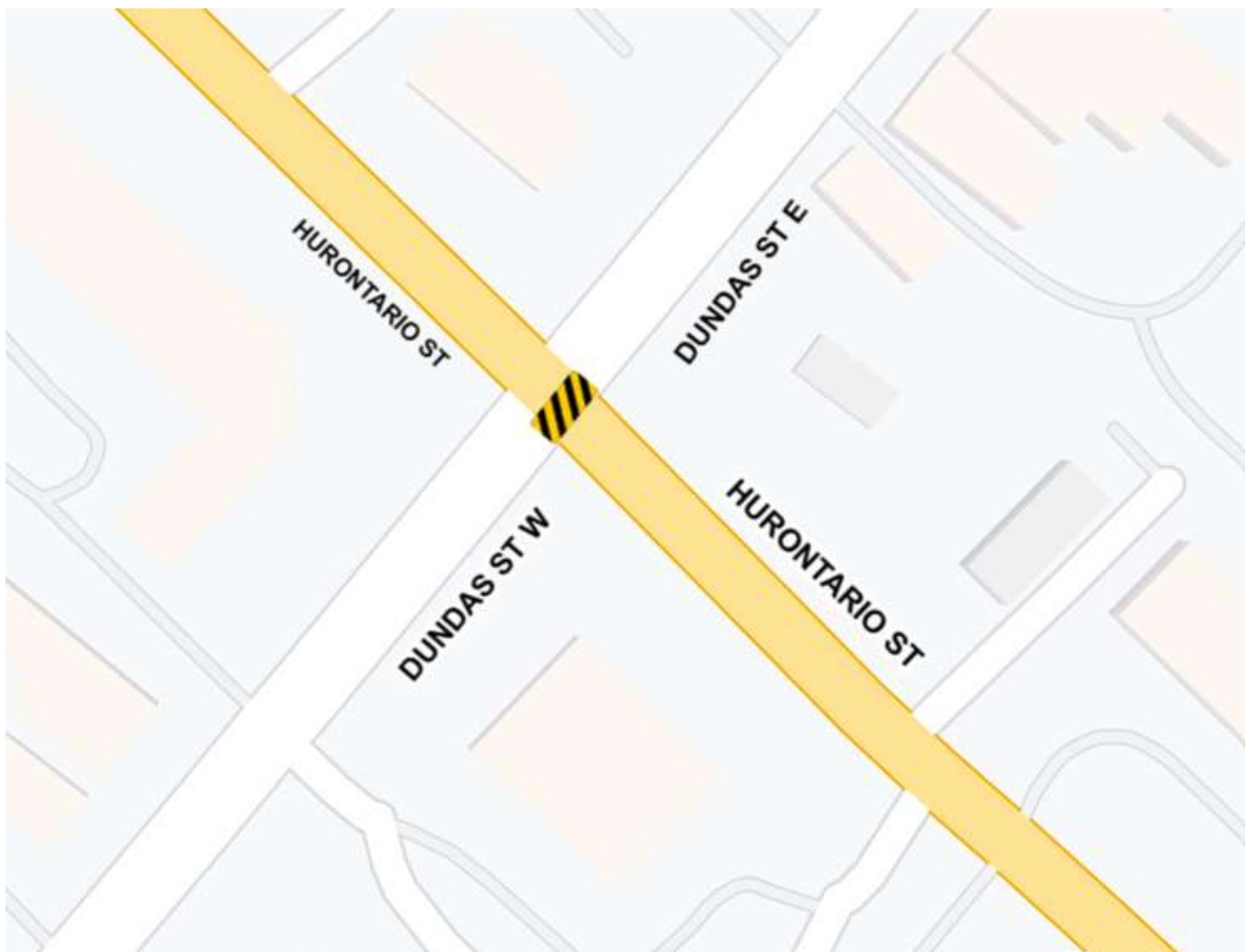


Nighttime Duct Bank Installations at Dundas Street and Hurontario Street

From October 15 to November 1, 2024



What work is taking place?

Crews will be installing telecommunication duct banks at the intersection of Dundas Street and Hurontario Street. This work is being scheduled during nights from October 15 to November 1, 2024, excluding Sundays, to minimize impacts and to get the work done in efficient manner. The work hours are from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. The roadway will be re-opened each morning with the steel plates.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- The work is being scheduled during nights from October 15 to November 1, 2024, excluding Sundays.
- The works hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Traffic lanes will be impacted. Please follow the signs.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work sites.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Bus stops near Hurontario and Dundas might be relocated. Please visit www.miway.ca for more details.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure that all private elements including benches and water sprinklers are removed from public lands.
