

Equipment Removal at Corktown

Expected date: As early as October 16, 2024



What to expect

- Crews are preparing to move drill rigs off-site by escort at the future station in Corktown, as early as Wednesday, October 16th.
- The drill rigs will be loaded onto oversized flatbed trucks within the site. The move is expected to happen during daytime hours, between 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Potential temporary lane and sidewalk restrictions may be required for crews to safely guide and assist the construction vehicles to enter and leave the Parliament Street access gate for the north site and Berkeley Street access gate from the south site. The oversized flatbed trucks will travel southbound on Parliament to Lakeshore Boulevard East Westbound or eastward on Eastern Avenue to the Don Valley Parkway.

- Traffic control persons will assist the maneuvering of the oversized flatbed vehicle entering and exiting the sites, ensuring the safety of pedestrians, cyclists, vehicles and public transit movement at all times.
- All sidewalk and lane restrictions are temporary and intermittent and regular traffic (pedestrian, cycling, vehicle, public transit) resumed after the oversized flatbeds and construction vehicles clear the entry and exit point of the site.
- TTC service will be maintained at all times.
- Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times in the east, west, north and south directions.
- All the necessary permits have been obtained.
- Equipment demobilization may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
