

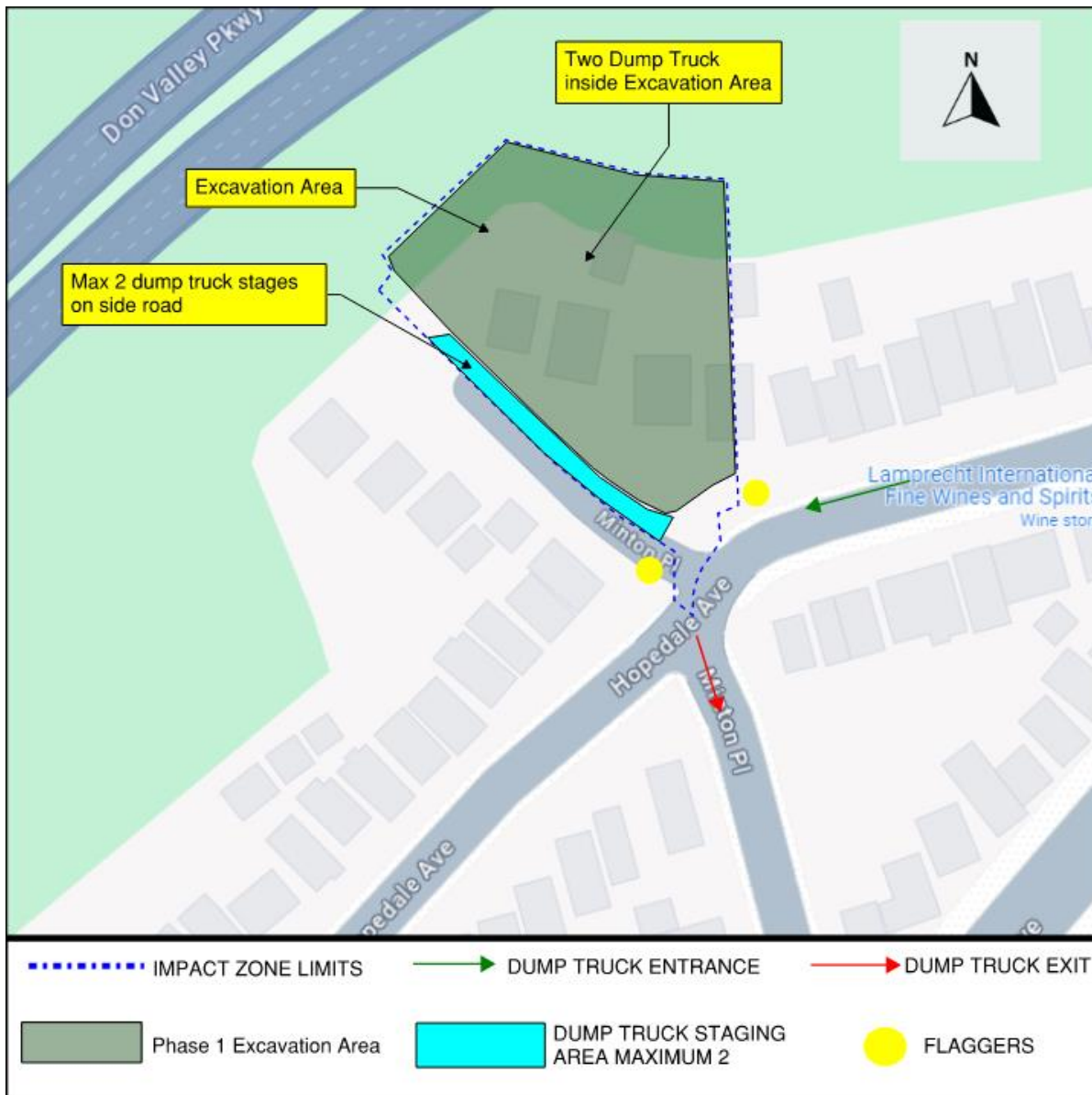

Phase 1 Excavation & Backfill at Minton Place

Expected start date: October 21st, 2024

Expected duration: Three (3) weeks

Hours of work: Monday - Friday: 7:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m



What is happening?

Excavation and backfilling works will be occurring for the Minton Place Portal structure. The excavation work will happen in 2 phases: Phase 1 will start as early as October 21st, 2024. Phase 2 will commence in spring 2025.

Phase 1:

- To accommodate the construction of the Minton Portal, Phase 1 will involve excavation and backfilling activities at the Minton Place construction site.
- Excavation and backfilling are done to prepare the site for construction laydown requirements. The first two meters of the site will be excavated.
- Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday beginning on October 21st.
- Construction equipment, such as an excavator, bulldozer, smooth drum packer, and dump trucks will be on site and parked on the roadway throughout the duration of these works.
- Traffic impacts include dump trucks entering the site via Hopedale Avenue will exit via Minton Place towards Pape Avenue.

What to Expect

- During Phase 1, which includes excavation and backfilling, community members can expect noise, dust, dirt, and vibration from construction equipment.
- Vibration and noise levels will be measured on an ongoing basis and mitigations implemented if an exceedance occurs. Mitigations for any noise or vibration exceedances include the installation of a noise barrier, slowing the speed of work, and/or changing the construction equipment used on site.
- Dust mitigation measures include using a water truck on site to moisten soil to prevent its spread. The contractor will also continue sweeping streets in the area to limit the spread of dust and maintain cleanliness.
- Traffic control personnel will direct construction vehicles and workers safely and efficiently to the work zone, minimizing traffic disruptions.
- Work zones will be marked using signage and safety barriers.
- Construction equipment and materials will be securely stored within designated work zones to ensure safety and prevent unauthorized access.
- There will be no impact on TTC bus or subway service because of this work.
