# Construction Liaison Committee Update

## ONGOING CONSTRUCTION:

## **Utility and Road Works**

The installation of watermain, storm, and sanitary systems continues in various areas along the west side of Hurontario Street between The Queensway and Matthews Gate. Crews are currently installing a new watermain between The Queensway and Dundas Street. Watermain connections are also ongoing between Fairview Road and Burnhamthorpe Road.



Please note that overnight watermain works in the area between The Queensway and Dundas have been completed and are now occurring during the daytime.

Lane reductions are in effect along Hurontario Street throughout the project corridor. We encourage motorists to plan for delays and recommend entering properties by turning right to get in and exiting properties by turning right to get out. Please follow the signage in place and do not use private laneways and plaza parking lots as detour routes. For safety, pedestrians and cyclists are reminded to use designated crossings and intersections and are advised to avoid jaywalking at all times. Access to worksites is restricted to authorized personnel only, and members of the general public are not permitted to enter for safety reasons.

# Tree Trimming, Protections, and Removals

The Hurontario LRT team has been working with an arborist to determine any tree impacts as construction moves forward to ensure proper arboriculture techniques are employed and to confirm protection or removal requirements for trees located along the boulevard. These requirements have been developed by a certified arborist in consultation with the City of Mississauga and Metrolinx.

Every reasonable attempt has been made to protect the trees we can as well as to reduce the need for tree removals. To minimize the impacts of construction on the natural environment, Mobilinx has fenced off public trees that have been identified by an arborist for protection.



City or private trees that need to be removed will be replaced in accordance with the City of Mississauga permit requirements. We will continue to work with private property owners on an individual basis for private tree impacts that have been identified on their property.
