

UPDATE: Pedestrian Detour at Queen Street West near Yonge Street

Expected start date: As early as **October 9, 2024**

Expected duration: Approximately one month

What is happening?

- Construction is underway for the Ontario Line station at Queen. To conduct utility work near the site, crews require access to the south sidewalk on Queen Street West, near Yonge Street.
- To ensure safe passage around the worksite, a pedestrian detour will be in place during this work.
- **The current pedestrian detour will remain in place.**
- **As early as October 24, 2024, the work zone will be extended by approximately 2 meters, next to the TTC entrance on the south side of Queen Street West, near Yonge Street.**
- **For safety, crews will shift the fencing and pedestrian detour route to accommodate this new work zone. This shift is expected to take place overnight.**
- **There will be no impact to TTC access as a result of this extension of the work zone.**

What to expect

- For approximately one month, pedestrians will be detoured around a work zone on Queen Street West, near Yonge Street (refer to graphic).

As early as October 24, 2024, crews will extend the pedestrian detour on the south side of Queen Street West, near Yonge Street.

- **Crews will work overnight from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. to adjust fencing around the work zone, with the newly configured area expected to be in place as of the morning of October 25, 2024.**
- **The detour is expected to be in place for approximately one month.**
- **No impact to TTC access is expected.**
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.

Note:

- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
