Aurora GO Station Improvements

As part of the GO Expansion project, improvements are coming to Aurora GO Station. Improvements include constructing a second platform, installing a second track, upgrading rail signals, building a new pedestrian tunnel with elevators, and installing tactile tiles on the existing east platform for improved accessibility.

What is happening?

To support the station improvements, Metrolinx will be installing storm drains along the Barrie GO rail corridor. This work will require excavation of a trench down to culvert level and installation of concrete pipes and storm drains.

As with all construction, work may be adjusted, rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to expect

Construction will begin Saturday October 26th and will last until Sunday October 27th. Work will occur between the hours of 7:00am - 5:00pm.

To safely install the storm drains, there will be no GO train service starting after 10pm on Friday, October 25th to Sunday, October 27th. All rail replacement buses will operate between Highway 407 Bus Terminal and Barrie Bus Terminal, serving all regular train stops except Downsview Park GO and Union Station Bus Terminal. Customers intending to travel to or from Union Station or Downsview Park GO can connect at Highway 407 Station via TTC Line 1 (Yonge-University).

Crews will also conduct vegetation removals within the rail corridor to enable the ground excavation and storm drain installation. There will be no outages or disruption of utility service during this work.

Nearby residents can expect to experience noise associated with general construction activities and equipment (such as excavators, loaders, skid steers and rock trucks). Sound monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise and vibration levels do not exceed a 70-decibel limit in compliance to the Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruption.
