

Full and partial closures of Warden Avenue

November 2024 - **DATES TO BE CONFIRMED**



Project Overview

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15-minutes or better on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible services. To enable this improved service, we must widen the railway corridor in this area including the bridges, to build an additional railway track and get ready for future electrification of the route.

What is happening?

In late-October, construction crews will be working on the railway bridge over Warden Avenue between Hollis and Danforth Avenues. We will need to close the road completely from November XX- XY and there will be partial closures from November XX - XY with a single lane open in each direction.

Installation of metal girders between the bridge piers and works to secure them in place.	Full closure of Warden Ave (TBD) Partial closure (TBD)	Daily (XX - XY November) 6.30am-6.00pm	During the full road closure, we will be using a mobile crane to install metal girders across the road between the bridge piers. During the partial closure we will be working on the girders and from the street level to permanently secure them.

HOURS OF WORK

- We will be working from 6.30am until 6pm every day throughout the construction period.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Residents should expect some noise, vibration and potentially site lighting. Some dust may be generated from the construction activities.
- Our staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows (if used)
 - The work area will be safely secured.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- During the full closure (TBD), Warden Ave will be completely closed to road traffic and pedestrians between Danforth and Hollis Avenues.
- During the partial closure (TBD), we will always keep one side of the central pier open to traffic and pedestrians, keeping one lane of traffic flowing in each direction and the sidewalk.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the vicinity of the work area.
