

Periodic Saturday Work at Corktown Station Sites

Expected start date: Saturday, October 26, 2024

Hours of work: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Expected completion: End of November 2024

What is happening?

- To maintain the schedule and progress of station construction, general works will be carried out periodically on Saturdays, starting October 26 and continuing through November 30, 2024
- This is in addition to the current Monday to Friday work schedule.
- Work is expected to take place between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Residents will see equipment moving around the site and hear construction noise from various machinery, as well as vehicles entering and exiting the site.
- To reduce the impact to residents and businesses in the area, mitigation measures are in place, which include noise and vibration monitoring, no overnight work and enhanced site hoarding.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstance.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips each day.
