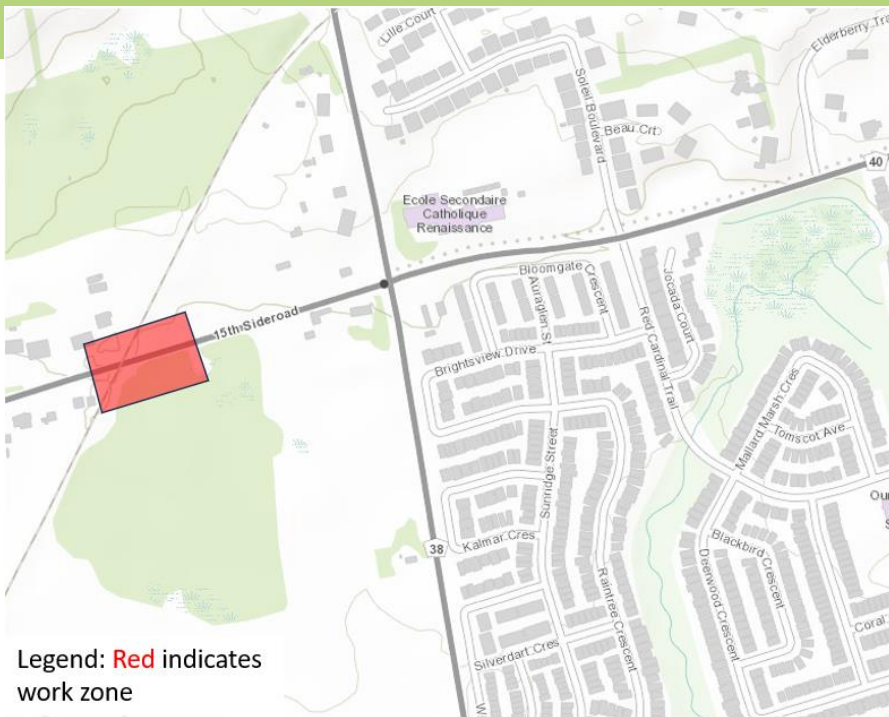


Barrie Corridor: Replacement of Utility Poles & Cables at 15th Sideroad & Bathurst

Monday November 14th to Friday December 20th, 8:00AM-5:00PM



- Westbound lane on 15th sideroad will be closed to facilitate construction. Traffic diversion will be in place to keep vehicles moving.
- Work will be completed during the day and will not involve work in the overnight hours.

What to expect

Construction will begin Monday November 11th to Friday December 20th. Work will occur between the hours of 8:00AM-5:00PM. **Please note that work may be delayed or extended due to unforeseen circumstances and weather.**

To safely remove the old hydro cables, pole, conductors and install the new poles and conductors, The level crossing on 15th sideroad will be reduced to one lane of traffic. Residents should expect increased traffic and construction crews directing traffic flow.

Overview

Metrolinx is continuing to make progress on upgrades to the Barrie corridor in support of GO Expansion and future electrification. Starting this November, we will be pulling and terminating hydro cables and poles and conductors from OH to UG as well installing new poles and conductors.

What does this mean to you?

- Nearby residents will experience noise from the radial boom derrick (RBD) truck.
