

# Temporary Road Closure: Thornridge Drive, between Yonge Street & Elizabeth Street

**Schedule:** October 28, 2024 - November 22, 2024

**Timing:** 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (Monday to Friday)

## What is happening?

A section of Thornridge Drive between Yonge Street and Elizabeth Street will be temporarily closed during work hours to accommodate work to support future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension. Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx (under contract for Alectra, the local utility provider) will be installing electrical infrastructure beneath Thornridge Drive.

## About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 subway service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. This extension includes five subway stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Excavators, vacuum trucks, and hammering tools and machinery will be used during work hours.
- Noise and vibration from construction vehicles and equipment will be noticeable while work is underway.
- Work areas will be clearly marked with barricades and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers.
- Construction vehicles, material, and equipment will be stored within a temporarily secured area on Thornridge Drive (see map).
- No power or utility interruptions are expected.
- Debris will be removed, and work areas will be restored after work is complete.

### DETOURS FOR LOCAL TRAFFIC

- Detour routes will be clearly marked.
- Traffic coming Southbound, should take Old Jane Street. Local access will be provided to enter the Plaza leading to the addresses 11, 13, 15, and 16 Thornridge Drive.
- Traffic coming Northbound should take Arnold Avenue. Local access will be provided to enter the Plaza leading to the addresses 11, 13, 15, and 16 Thornridge Drive.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- The section of Thornridge Drive marked on the map in red will be closed to vehicles during work hours, (Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.).
- With no sidewalks or bike lanes between Yonge Street and Elizabeth Street on Thornridge Drive, onsite crew can guide pedestrians and cyclists safely through the work zone during the construction.
- Thornridge Drive will be re-open daily at 5:30 p.m.
