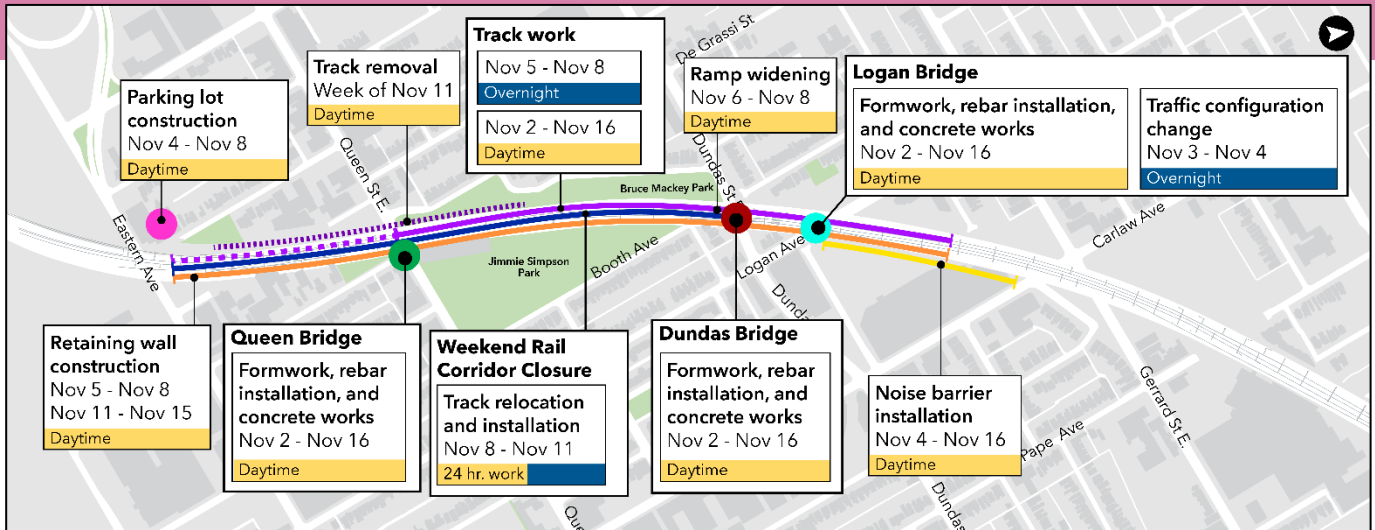


Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, November 2 - Saturday, November 16, 2024

Hours of work:

- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with periodic weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday - Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity - further details below).



This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.

What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. **Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

Crews will do their best to limit disruptive work overnight.</p>
<p>● WEEKEND RAIL CORRIDOR CLOSURE: Friday November 8 - Monday November 11, 2024 24 hr. weekend work</p>	<p>Within the rail corridor between Eastern Ave. and Dundas St. E.</p>	<p>Track relocation and installation The Lakeshore East rail corridor will be shut down to install new train tracks. Construction activities will include rail cutting, backfilling, compaction, and track installations. Crews will do their best to schedule more disruptive activities during the day to minimize overnight disruption.</p>
<p>● Sunday November 3 starting at 6 p.m. until the morning of Monday, November 4 at 5 a.m.</p>	<p>Logan Avenue between Dundas Street East and First Avenue</p>	<p>NEW ACTIVITY: Traffic Configuration Change Reinstating southbound traffic on Logan Ave. between Dundas St. and First Ave. Two lanes of traffic (one northbound and one southbound) will be in place on Logan Ave. as of Nov 3, 2024. Traffic lanes will be on the east side the road. The west sidewalk on Logan Ave. will remain closed. The east sidewalk will be open.</p>

Saturday November 2 - Saturday November 16, 2024	Queen, Dundas, and Logan bridges	Formwork, rebar installation, and concrete works <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Daytime work at Dundas bridge on Sat Nov. 2 Daytime concrete breaking at Logan Ave. bridge on Sun Nov. 3. Daytime rebar installations at Dundas St. on Sun Nov. 3. Concrete pour at Dundas bridge on Mon Nov. 4 and Wed Nov. 6 starting at 6 a.m. for approx. eight hours
Tuesday November 5 - Friday November 8, 2024, and continuing Monday November 11 - Friday November 15, 2024	Within the rail corridor between Dundas St. E. and Thackeray St.	Retaining wall construction Placing concrete blocks, backfilling, and compaction work *Residents in nearby properties may feel vibrations during compaction work; noise and vibration monitoring is in place to ensure regulatory limits are maintained.
Wednesday November 6 - Friday November 8, 2024	**Booth Avenue and Paisley Avenue corner	NEW ACTIVITY: Ramp widening work Widening the access ramp at the Dundas bridge to prepare for the weekend track closure. Periodic vibrations from compaction work can be expected.
Monday November 4 - Saturday November 16, 2024	Within the rail corridor between Logan Ave. and Carlaw Ave.	Noise barrier installation Drilling foundations, grading, and installing noise barrier panels.
Saturday November 2 - Saturday November 16, 2024	Within the rail corridor between Eastern Ave. and Thackeray St. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Most track work will take place between Queen St. and Dundas St. for the week of November 4 Ongoing track work between Eastern Ave. and Queen St. may be required NEW LOCATION: *On the week of November 11, track removals will begin on the north side of the corridor (opposite Saulter St., Strange St., and Degross St.)	Track work Shifting tracks, replacing track ties, compaction, and backfilling ballast. *Residents in nearby properties may experience noise vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits. Track removal work will begin on the north side of the corridor the week of November 11. This activity will involve cutting tracks with rail saws, disassembling rail, loading cut rail into bins, and hauling materials off site.

What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implemented to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
