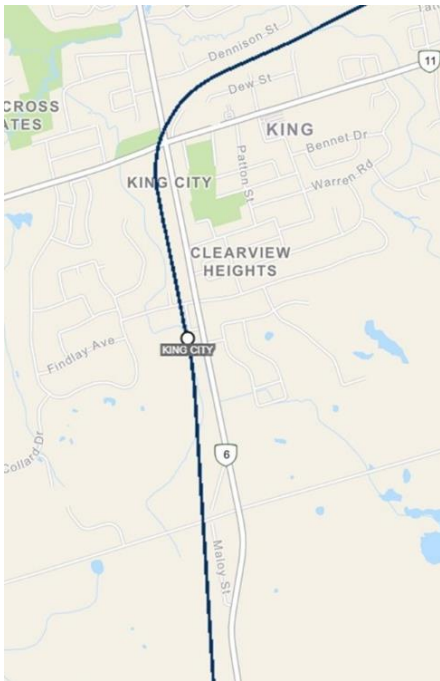


Barrie Corridor Vegetation Removals Between Vaughan and Aurora

November 4th, 2024 to March 31st, 2025



What is happening?

Work is underway to deliver the GO Expansion Program and prepare for the future electrification of GO service. To support this work, Metrolinx will need to clear, remove and prune designated trees and vegetation located within and along the Barrie rail corridor between Keele Street and Dufferin Street, and between Kirby Road and 15th Sideroad. Some of this work (including vegetation removals at King City GO) was carried out between September 2023 and March 2024.

What does this mean for you?

Noise

Residents and businesses near the rail corridor can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, chainsaws, woodchippers and other construction equipment related to this work. Work will be conducted quickly and as efficiently as possible to minimize disturbances.

Tree Markings

You may also see dots on the trees within and along the rail corridor that have been identified for removal.

Will there be restoration?

Once cleared, growth control zones will be established to manage vegetation inside the corridors over the long term. Trees removed as part of this work within King Township and the City of Vaughan will be replaced through a tree restoration program based on the Metrolinx Vegetation Guideline (2022).

Work hours

This work will take place from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Sunday to Saturday.
