

Fence Installation along Kitchener Corridor at Brownville Avenue

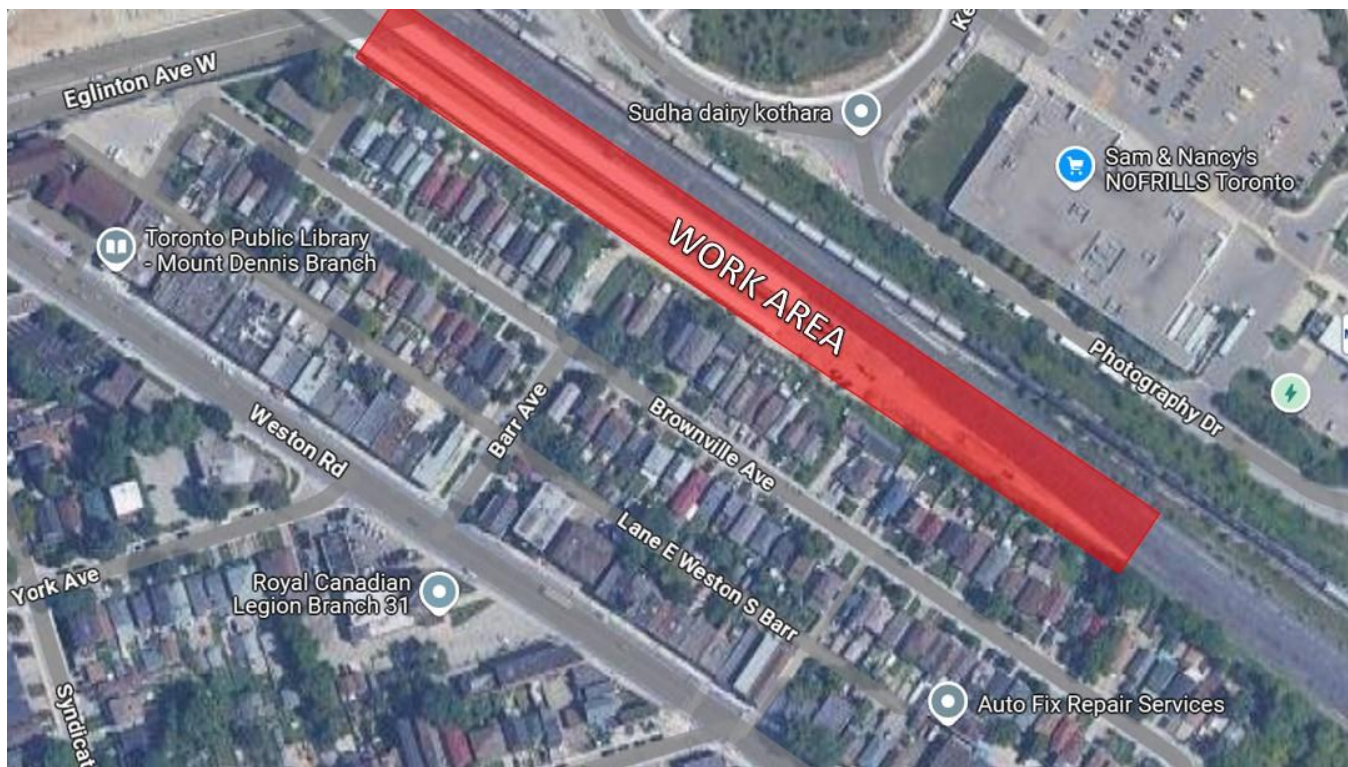


Figure 1: Aerial photograph showing the approximate location of the work zone. Not to scale. For illustrative purposes only.

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

Starting November 11th to the 13th the contractor hired by Metrolinx will be on site to clear area of vegetation and small trees within 3 feet from fence line inside the Metrolinx rail corridor. Working hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

From November 18th to 20th, surveying and staking of property lines, will begin. This will include layout design around larger trees. Working hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

From November 25th to 29th, locates will be completed.

Starting as early as January 6th, 2025 fence installation will begin. Work is expected to take up to 6 days to complete. Access point of Brownville Avenue will be gained by removing fence panel and potentially the traffic barrier (if required). This access point will be re-secured temporarily at the end of each shift, and once installation has been completed.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Usage of outdoor equipment and power tools, including chainsaws.
- Elevated noise level and light levels to the residences surrounding the project area.
- All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts.

HOURS OF WORK

- 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Monday to Friday).
- Please note, dates may be changed due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are no anticipated impacts to traffic.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no anticipated impacts to traffic.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to train operations along the kitchener corridor.
