

E.T. Seton Park Archery Range Reconfiguration

What is happening?

Reconfiguration of E.T. Seton Park Archery Range

- Metrolinx is undertaking the construction of the West Don Crossing bridge structure as part of the Ontario Line project.
- To ensure the safety of the public, range users and workers, Metrolinx reconfigured the E.T. Seton Park Archery Range.
- As part of this process, Metrolinx engaged archery range users to identify their needs and is making the following changes as a result of their feedback.
- Changes include:
 - The addition of four (4) boards to the 18-meter target, one (1) board at the 60-meter target, and one (1) board at the 70-meter target.
 - Flattening of mounds within the range.
 - The extension of wooden fencing beyond the 18-meter target.
- This will require the temporary closure of the archery range to reconfigure its layout to ensure public and worker safety.
- The reconfiguration is expected to begin as early as November 18th, 2024.

What to Expect

- The E.T. Seton Park Archery Range will be closed for up to one week, pending good weather conditions.
- During the closure, the archery range will be reconfigured to accommodate requests made by archery range users.
- After reopening the archery range, users will continue to see construction traffic in the vicinity of the area.
- Dust and vibration levels from construction activities will be monitored to mitigate any potential impacts to archery range users.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
