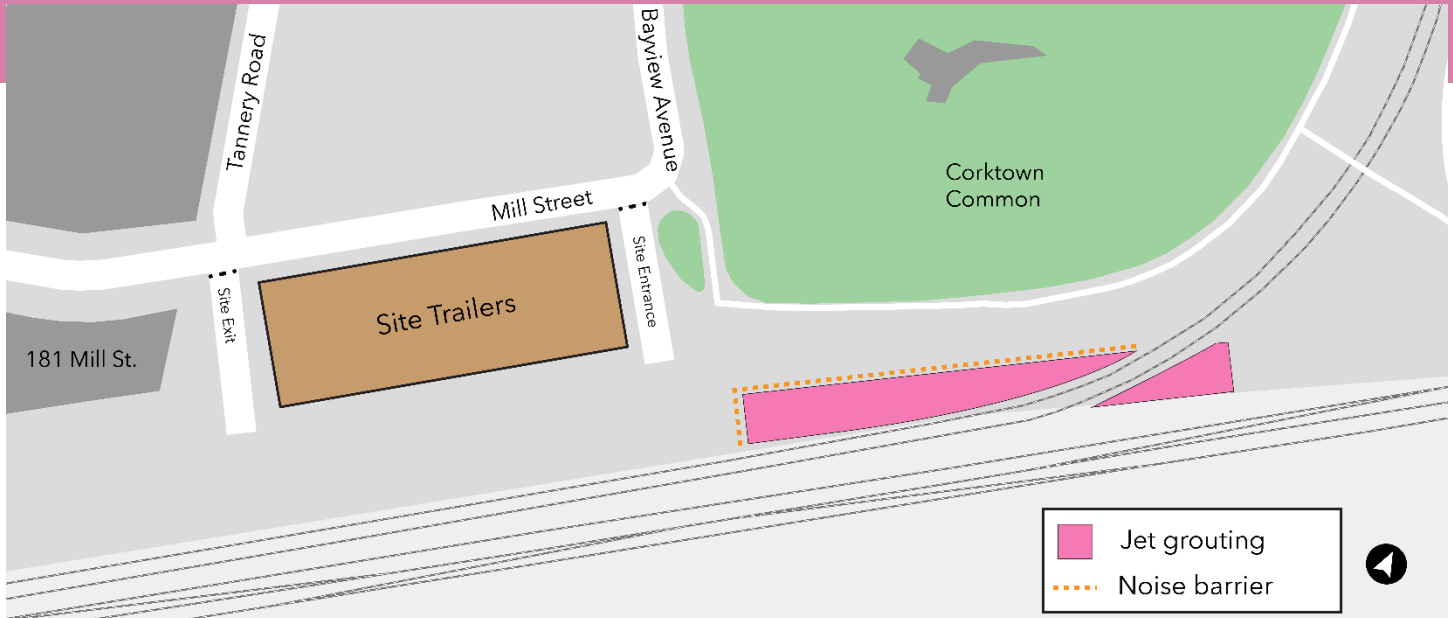


Jet Grouting Work in the Don Yard

Starting in late November 2024 for approximately seven (7) months

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday during the day and night



What is happening?

- In late November 2024, jet grouting work will begin in the Don Yard.
- Jet grouting is a soil stabilization technique that involves injecting grout deep into the soil. The grout replaces the existing soil and hardens, adding stability near where excavation work will occur.
- Jet grouting is required to improve soil conditions prior to constructing the new subway portal.
- Jet grouting is a continuous operation and must take place during the day and night, to maintain proper ground conditions and allow equipment to operate safely.
- **This work will take place near the east side of the Don Yard site (see map above) over 200 meters away from 181 Mill Street (Maple House Condos) - minimal to no noise is expected.**

What to expect

- Construction equipment including compressors, small drills, and trucks will be used to complete this work.
- The jet grouting does not require pile drilling, removal of spoils, or auger shaking/banging.
- Noise levels will be significantly lower than pile drilling or auger shaking/banging.
- Equipment will be covered with acoustic blankets to mitigate noise.
- Noise testing will be conducted a week before overnight work starts to ensure noise levels from jet grouting are within acceptable limits.
- Construction of the new subway portal and tunnel will continue into 2028 - jet grouting work will take place until approximately Summer 2025.
- No traffic or pedestrian impacts are expected.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zone.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line
