## WHAT TO EXPECT?

Construction on the Burloak Grade Separation project is moving forward. With input from the community, we have adjusted our plans. Instead of a 14-month road closure, a four-lane detour road will be built to maintain access along Burloak Drive. Minor preparation work will take place this year, with further updates to follow in the new year.

This decision, made in partnership with the City of Burlington and the Town of Oakville, reflects the community's desire to minimize construction impacts while ensuring continued access for residents and local businesses. We regularly review options to balance minimizing impact to communities while delivering the best transit infrastructure solutions for the project. While shorter-term road closures (up to 30 days) will still be necessary to facilitate construction, including to shift traffic to the detour road, we are working closely with local stakeholders to ensure minimal inconvenience. Additional details will follow as the project progresses.

Thank you for your cooperation as we work to transform the rail corridor in your area.
