

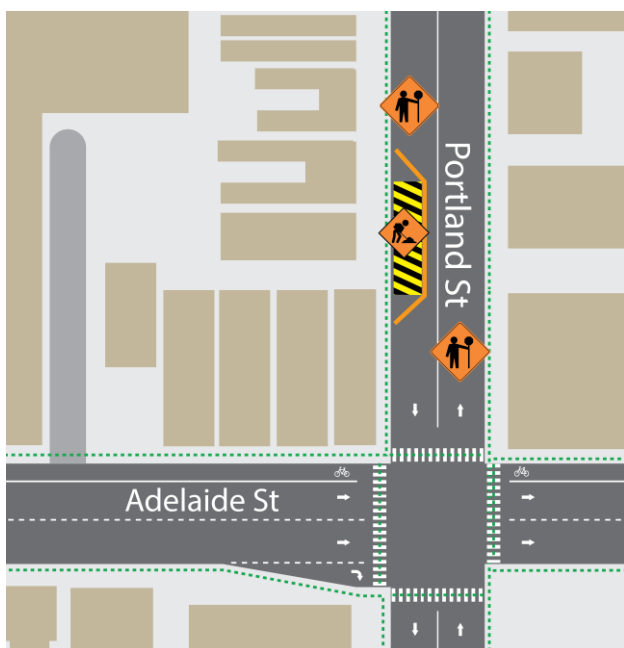
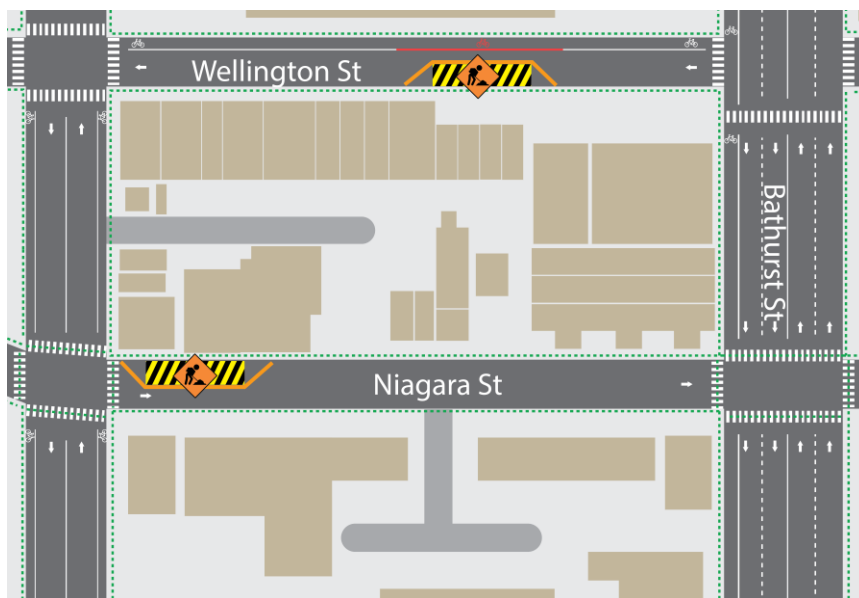
# Well decommissioning at King Street West and Bathurst Street

**Expected start date:** February 26, 2024

## What is happening?

To enable further construction of the Ontario Line at the future King-Bathurst Station, crews will be undertaking well decommissioning activities in and around the King Street West and Bathurst Street neighbourhood as of February 26, 2024.

- The work is done by accessing well casings at street level to assess internal conditions, removing pipes, and backfilling the hole.
- Ground water monitoring is an important part of underground works. To ensure that readings are accurate during works, the old water monitoring points must be sealed off.
- The work at will occur over a one-day period, on February 26, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## What to expect

- Nearby residents may hear noise related to the work such as hydraulic jacks and cement mixers as crews work to decommission old wells.
- Work crews will remove the casing of the wells and remove existing piping.
- Once the piping is extracted, the well hole will be filled with a strengthening filler material called bentonite, and then topped off with concrete, up to street level.
- Once the well is filled and decommissioned, crews will ensure the work area is clear of any potential hazards and debris before moving to the next location.
- Pylons will be used to separate laneways where work is occurring from active traffic lanes.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
