

# Oversized truck deliveries at Queen-Spadina

**Expected start date:** As early as December 13, 2024

**Expected duration:** Staggered days and times, to early January 2025

**Hours of work:** Various, including overnight

## What is happening?

As part of ongoing construction of the Ontario Line and the future station site at Queen-Spadina, oversized machinery and materials will be delivered to the site. These deliveries are expected to happen on various days and times over the next two weeks.

The delivery of oversized machinery and material requires specialized permits and traffic control personnel to safely guide the equipment into and out of the site. To reduce traffic impacts at this downtown intersection, deliveries are often scheduled in the overnight period, while maintaining safe operations and passage for vehicles and pedestrians in the area.

## What to expect

- Oversized machinery and materials will be delivered to the Queen-Spadina north station site via Bulwer Street.
- Deliveries will take place on various days and times over the next several weeks, including during overnight or early morning hours.
- Deliveries may require a short-term closure of the sidewalk at Spadina Avenue, while the equipment is being delivered to the worksite. These operations will be supported by traffic control personnel who will guide pedestrians and cyclists safely.
- Pedestrians and cyclists are asked to co-operate with traffic control personnel, and cyclists are recommended to dismount when traveling through these areas.
- Residents may expect some noise on-site from vehicle reverse alarms.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary permits have been obtained.
