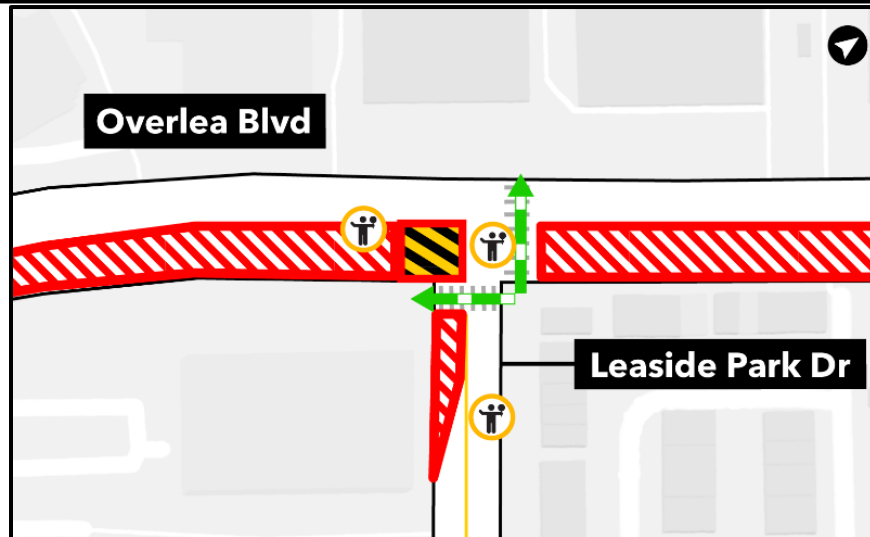


Watermain and Valve Chamber Construction at Leaside Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard with Temporary Water Shut-Offs

Expected Work Period: 7:00am on Monday, December 16, 2024 through 7:00pm on Thursday, December 19, 2024

Water Shut-Off Windows: 11:00pm to 6:30am the following morning on the three (3) nights of Monday, December 16; Tuesday, December 17; and Wednesday, December 18

West lane, sidewalk and crosswalk closed on Leaside Park Drive



Prior to each of the three (3) temporary water shut-offs, those living or working in the impacted properties should store water for their use overnight.

Impacted Properties

The following properties specifically will be impacted by the temporary water shut-offs on the dates in the header above. Each night, water service will be interrupted at approximately 11:00pm and will be restored by 6:30am the following morning.

- 1 and 5 Leaside Park Drive
- Leaside Park Drive townhouse complex

What is happening?

- To prepare water utility infrastructure for future stages of Ontario Line construction and facilitate future maintenance access, crews will be constructing a new underground valve chamber and watermain segment under Overlea Boulevard at Leaside Park Drive.
- The work will require that water be temporarily shut off at nearby properties supplied by the watermain.
- The temporary interruption to water service will take place on each of the three (3) nights of Monday, December 16; Tuesday, December 17; and Wednesday, December 18. Each night, the water shut-off will begin at approximately 11:00pm and end by 6:30am the following morning. **Please plan accordingly.**

What to expect

- One (1) of the two lanes on Leaside Park Drive will be closed at the intersection with Overlea Boulevard at all times (24 hours a day) during the work period. The adjacent sidewalk and north-south crosswalk across Overlea Boulevard will also be closed. The sidewalk on the south side of Overlea Boulevard will remain open.
- Two-way access will be maintained at all times on both Leaside Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard. There will be no turn restrictions.
- The intersection and single open lane on Leaside Park Drive will be controlled by a paid-duty police officer 24 hours a day during the construction period, including periods when no active work is taking place. Trained traffic control personnel will also assist with entry and exit to Leaside Park Drive during work hours.
- Drivers turning into or out of Leaside Park Drive may be asked to briefly queue while traffic in the opposite direction is allowed through the open lane. Please drive with caution and watch for pedestrians and cyclists when near the intersection and follow all directions from officers and traffic control personnel.
- Impacts to TTC bus service are not anticipated.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Work will be conducted using hydro-vacuum trucks, excavators, trucks, and other equipment.
- Noise, vibration, and air quality/dust impacts from the equipment listed are expected to be minimal and will be actively monitored and mitigated as needed.
- This work is being carried out in close collaboration with Toronto Water, and all required permits have been obtained from the City of Toronto for this work.
- This work may be delayed due to weather conditions and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
