Aurora GO Station Improvements

As part of the GO Expansion project, improvements are coming to Aurora GO Station. Improvements include installation of track signal equipment. This includes signal bungalows, signal towers, radio towers, and miscellaneous equipment structures.

To support these improvements, Metrolinx contractor **Grascan Construction Ltd** will undertake overnight track maintenance along the corridor.

What is happening?

As part of this work, contractors will be installing track signal equipment, signal bungalows, signal towers, radio towers, and miscellaneous equipment structures.

This includes locations near Wellington Street East, Centre Street, the west parking lot at Aurora GO, and adjacent to the corridor by Birch Court as indicated on the map. This track maintenance is in preparation for future track work that will be taking place to support the Aurora GO Station improvements.

As with all construction, work may be adjusted, rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to expect

Work is being done overnight while there is no train service to increase safety efforts. Construction activities will take place from January 20 to January 31 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Nearby residents can expect to experience noise associated with general construction activities and equipment (such as high rail boom trucks, pickup trucks, dump trucks, hydraulic excavators, and loader skid steers). Sound and Air monitoring technology will be utilized to the north and south ends of the working area to ensure that noise levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.

Contractors will ensure lights from equipment are faced away from residential homes to keep light pollution levels as low as possible.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. We understand that we are conducting track work in a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this critical work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
