


Watermain Installation Under Overlea Blvd at Millwood Rd, Leaside Park Dr, and Thorncliffe Park Dr W

Expected start date: As early as January 6, 2025
Expected duration: Approximately 6 to 12 days
Days of work: Monday - Saturday (no work on Sunday)
Hours of work: 7:00 am - 7:00 pm



What is happening?

- To prepare water utility infrastructure for future stages of Ontario Line construction, crews will be installing the watermain branch lines at the intersections on Overlea Blvd.
- Alternating lane, sidewalk, and crosswalk closures are required for the installation of critical sewer/water infrastructure under the intersection of Leaside Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard, Thorncliffe Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard, Millwood Road and Overlea Boulevard.
- The utility construction works will start as early as Monday, January 6, 2025, and will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- The works will take approximately six (6) to twelve (12) consecutive days to complete and may take place on any day of the week except for Sunday.
- Leaside Park will be reduced to one flagged lane during the day shift and one lane each direction will be reinstated at the end of each shift. The adjacent sidewalk and north-south crosswalk across Overlea Boulevard will also be closed.

What to expect

- **Two-way access will be maintained at all times** on both Leaside Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard. **There will be no turn restrictions.**
- The intersection and single open lane on Leaside Park Drive will be controlled by a paid-duty police officer during work hours. Trained traffic control personnel will also assist with entry and exit to Leaside Park Drive during work hours. One lane each direction during off work hours.
- **Two-way access will be maintained at all times** on both Thorncliffe Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard. **There will be no turn restrictions.**
- **Two-way access will be maintained at all times** on both Millwood Road and Overlea Boulevard. **There will be no turn restrictions.**
- TTC bus stops will not be affected.
- Advance signage and safety barriers will be in place to guide pedestrians, drivers, and cyclists.
- This work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
