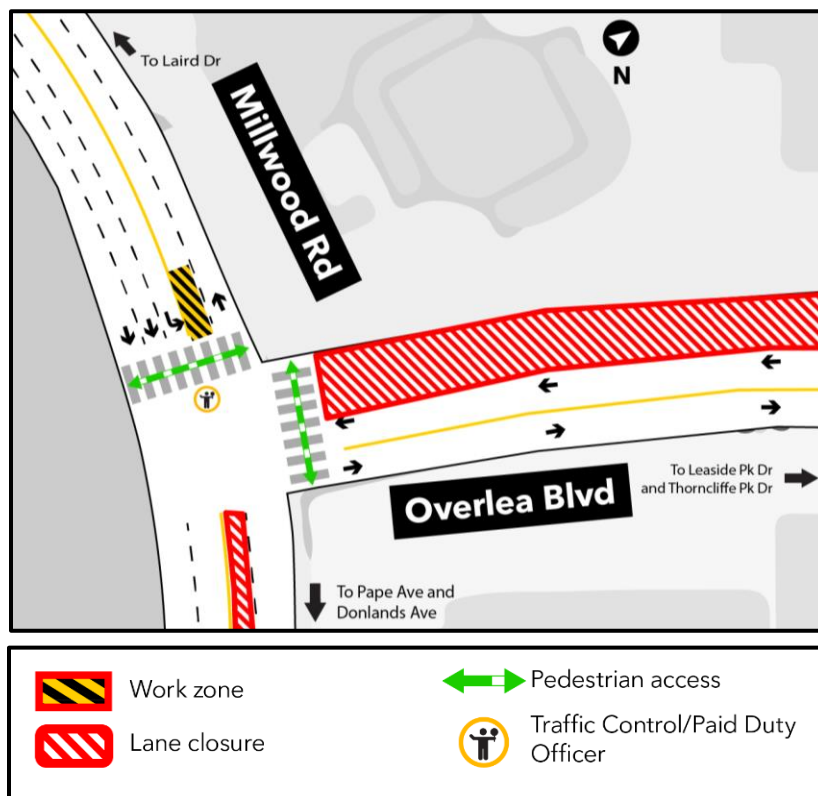


Watermain Valve Installation at Millwood Road and Overlea Boulevard with Temporary Water Shut-Off

Water Shut-Off Window (approximate): Starting 11:00pm on Wednesday, January 15 and ending by 6:30am on Thursday, January 16.

Expected work dates and times: 7:00am on Wednesday, January 15, 2025 (preparatory works only, **no water shut off before 11 pm**) through 6:30am on Thursday, January 16, 2025

Valve Installation Site: Intersection of Millwood Rd & Overlea Blvd



Before the water shut-off, those living or working in the impacted properties should store water for their use during this time.

Impacted Properties

The following properties will specifically be impacted by a water shut off. Water service will be interrupted at approximately 11:00pm and will be restored at approximately 6:30am.

- 11 and 21 Redway Road
- 1-3 Banigan Drive

- 1 Laird Drive

- 1070, 1073, 1075, 1080, 1100 Millwood Road

- 2, 4-8 Overlea Boulevard

What is happening?

- To prepare utility infrastructure for future stages of Ontario Line construction, crews will be constructing an underground chamber and installing a new watermain valve at the intersection of Millwood Road and Overlea Boulevard.
- Overnight between Wednesday, January 15 and Thursday, January 16 from approximately 11:00pm to 6:30am, water will be shut off to the properties listed above to safely put the new valve into service.

What to expect

- The left side northbound lane will be closed for brief stretches on Millwood Road both north and south of Overlea Boulevard to safely separate traffic from the work zone and to safely merge multiple lanes of traffic into the single open northbound lane as they approach the work zone.
- Please plan for extra time to travel through the Millwood Road & Overlea Boulevard intersection. A paid-duty police officer will be present in the intersection to assist with traffic control. Please follow all directions of traffic control personnel and drive with care around work crews, pedestrians, and cyclists in and around the intersection.
- TTC bus service will not be impacted by this work.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Work will be conducted using hydro-vacuum trucks, excavators, trucks, and other equipment.
- Noise, vibration, and air quality/dust impacts from the equipment listed are expected to be minimal and will be actively monitored and mitigated as needed.
- This work is being carried out in close collaboration with Toronto Water, and all required permits have been obtained from the City of Toronto for this work.
- This work may be delayed due to weather conditions and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
