
# **Construction sewer connection work on Sherbourne Street**

**Expected start date:** As early as January 31, 2025 **Expected end date:** Up until February 9, 2025 **Hours of work:** 12:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (weekdays) and 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (weekends)

#### What is happening?

As part of ongoing construction of the Ontario Line and the future Moss Park station, crews will be connecting below-ground sewer infrastructure.

The main work will be carried out in two phases, over two-weekends and will require a temporary lane closure on Sherbourne Street southbound, bike lane closure, a pedestrian sidewalk detour and a TTC bus stop relocation for the 75 Sherbourne bus, during the work period.

#### What to expect

- Temporary full closure of the southbound traffic and bicycle lane on Sherbourne Street southbound, north of Queen Street East.
- Temporary full closure of the west sidewalk on Sherbourne Street southbound, north of Queen Street East.
- Temporary relocation of the existing TTC bus stop north of Queen Street East on Sherbourne Street to its temporary location south of Queen Street East on Sherbourne Street.

- Paid duty officers and traffic flag-persons will assist with pedestrian, cyclist and vehicular traffic, with two-way traffic maintained at all times.
- Residents will see equipment moving around the work zone and hear construction noise from various machinery including saw cutting equipment and hydrovac trucks required to carry out exposure of underground utilities.
- If impact to water service is anticipated, affected properties will be notified one week in advance.

#### PHASE 1 SCHEDULE:

Friday, January 31, from 12:00 p.m. to Saturday, February 1, at 7:00 p.m. Sunday, February 2, at 7:00 a.m. to Monday, February 3, at 7:00 a.m.

• Temporary full closure of the west sidewalk on Sherbourne Street, north of Queen Street East. Pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the left of the work zone. See map above.

\*Sidewalk, bicycle lane, southbound traffic lane closures and TTC bus stop relocation will remain in effect from Friday, January 31, from 12:00 p.m. to Monday, February 3, at 7:00 a.m.

#### PHASE 2 SCHEDULE:

Saturday, February 8, at 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Sunday, February 9, at 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

• Temporary full closure of the west sidewalk on Sherbourne Street, north of Queen Street East. Pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the east of the work zone. See map above.

## \*Sidewalk, bicycle lane, southbound traffic lane closures and TTC bus stop relocation will remain in effect from Saturday, February 8, at 7:00 a.m. to Sunday, February 9, at 7:00 p.m.

- To reduce the impact to residents and businesses in the area, mitigation measures have been put into place, which include water suppression, noise and vibration monitoring, no overnight work.
- Signage will be in place to assist transit users, pedestrians and traffic through the work zones.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
