

Maple GO Station: Cantilever Arm Installation

Friday, January 24th – Sunday, January 26th, 2025 8PM-AM

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections.

Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

Metrolinx is continuing to make progress on upgrades along the Barrie rail corridor in support of GO Expansion!

As part of works for the future West track at Maple GO - a second track that will increase service at the station - Metrolinx will be implementing a double-lane closure on the south side to lay the foundation for and install a cantilever arm at a crossing along McNaughton Road at Maple GO. There will be single lane access east and west on the north two lanes of McNaughton.

These improvements will allow a crossing to be installed at the station at a later date, and the laydown of the second track in future. We thank you for your patience as we work to get you where you need to go, faster and easier.

What to expect

Nearby residents may experience limited noise from construction equipment including various trucks and a crane. A traffic management plan will be in place to allow vehicles and cyclists to smoothly navigate through this area of the street when the lane closures occur.
