

# Critical Infrastructure and Utility Works along Overlea Boulevard and Millwood Road: Stage 3 Commencement Update

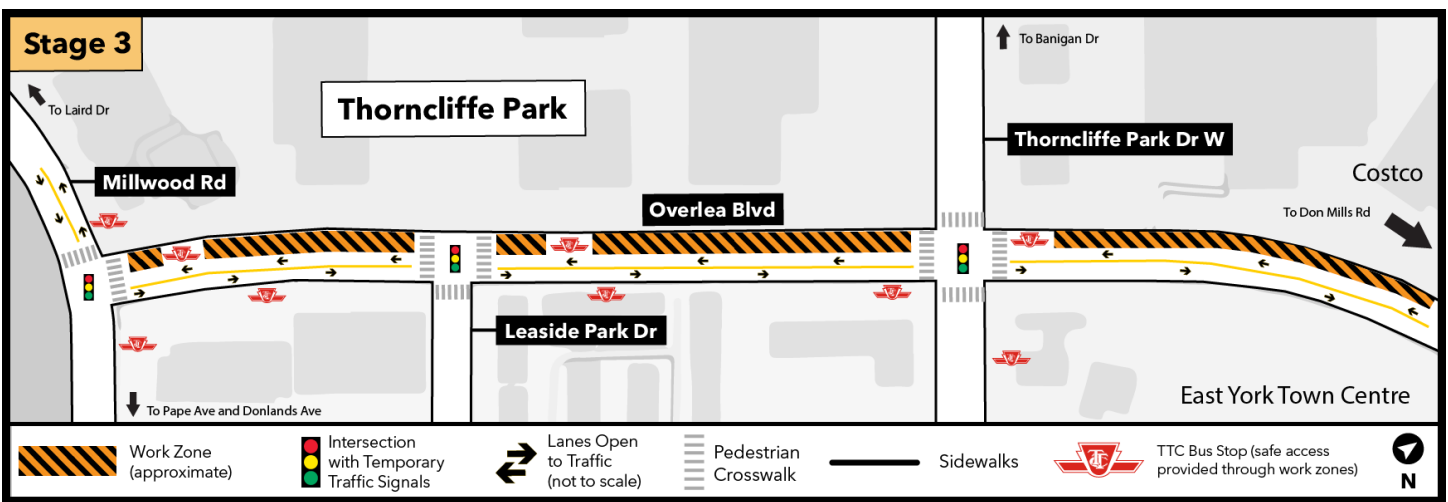
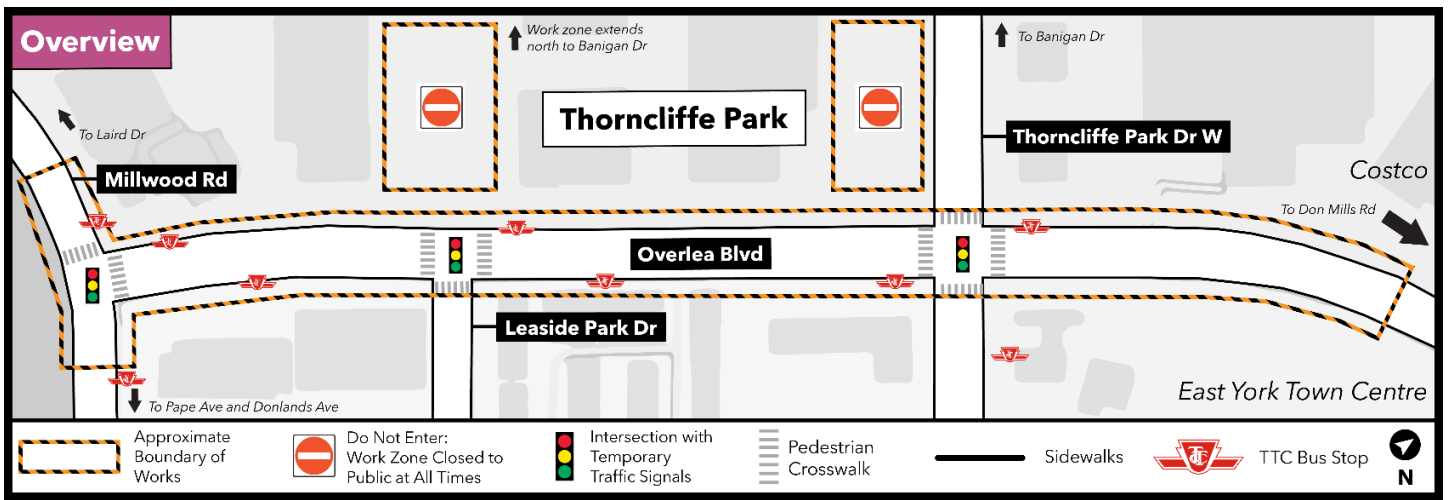
**Utility Works Sequence Start Date:** September 23, 2024 (Stage 1 of 3 began)

**Stage 3 Start Date:** Mid-January 2025

**Expected Completion:** By mid-March 2025

## What is happening?

- In late September 2024, crews began a sequence of critical utility infrastructure construction on Overlea Boulevard between Millwood Road and the block east of Thorncliffe Park Drive West (near Costco), and on Millwood Road immediately north and south of Overlea Boulevard. An overview map outlining the boundaries of these works is provided above.
- These advance works involve moving and upgrading underground utilities to prepare Thorncliffe Park for future phases of Ontario Line construction.
- Construction during the Fall 2024/Winter 2025 period includes the activities and locations described in the table below, spread across three consecutive stages:
  - **Stage 1** was completed by early December 2024.
  - **Stage 2** was completed by mid-January 2025.
  - **Stage 3** will begin shortly. It will last through approximately mid-March 2025 and construction activity will take place Monday to Saturday between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. A map of the Stage 3 work zones and traffic configuration is provided above.
- After Stage 3 is complete, crews will re-mobilize in Spring 2025 to restore the condition and appearance of roads, sidewalks, and landscaping at street level. A new notice will be issued closer to the start of these future restoration works.

## What to expect

- **At least one lane in each direction will remain open along Overlea Boulevard and Millwood Road at all times.** Please refer to the Stage 3 traffic configuration map provided above.

- The sidewalk along the north side of Overlea Boulevard adjacent to the work zone will remain open, however individual construction activities on utilities under the sidewalk may require brief, temporary closures of certain stretches for safety. Clear pedestrian detour signage will be in place in these instances.
- Motorists and transit riders are advised to plan for additional time to reach their destination, as it may take longer than normal to travel through the area during construction.
- TTC buses will maintain their regular routing. Safe access will be provided through work zones, connecting existing bus stops to a temporary boarding platform via a ramp and corridor from the sidewalk.
- Work will be conducted using a variety of equipment such as excavators, dump trucks, hydrovac trucks, cement trucks, and paving equipment.
- Traffic control personnel will manage truck and construction equipment traffic entering and exiting work zones. Traffic disruptions from truck and equipment movements will be minimal and brief.
- Noise, vibration, and air quality impacts from equipment are expected to be minimal, however they will be actively monitored. Water will be used to mitigate any dust.
- All required permits have been obtained from the City of Toronto.
- Construction activity will occur on Metrolinx and City of Toronto property.
- **Construction may be delayed due to extreme weather** and/or unforeseen circumstances.

## About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
