What is happening?

Lane Reduction on Charles Hiscott Bridge on Overlea Boulevard

- From February 5th to the 7th, a detailed visual inspection of the Charles Hiscott Bridge over the Don River on Overlea Boulevard will be carried out.
- This is an agreement with City of Toronto and Metrolinx as part of the bridge monitoring
 program prior to the completion of the bridge rehabilitation to be completed by the City of
 Toronto.
- This will require the use of a bridgemaster (under bridge inspection vehicle) to inspect the underside of the deck, including the soffit and structural steel members. As a result, single lane closures will be required.

- Single lane closures will be carried out on one lane in both Eastbound and Westbound directions at separate periods.
- These works will be conducted between 9:00am and 4:00pm. Lane closures will not be concurrent, but commuters can expect eastbound and westbound closures during the dates and times indicated.
- Traffic control personnel will be present to direct traffic and traffic signage will be posted around the area.
- Local commutes and TTC bus service could be impacted or delayed.

What to Expect

- The single lane closures will occur separately on Eastbound and Westbound lanes.
- They will be carried out between February 5th and 7th between 9:00am and 4:00pm.
- Delays can be expected on Overlea Boulevard. All efforts will be made to mitigate impacts to the local community, motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists. Pedestrian traffic below the bridge will be monitored and controlled when operations above are in progress. Traffic control personnel will be present to direct traffic and traffic signage will be posted around the area. The traffic control plan will be in accordance with the Ontario Traffic Manual Book 7.
