

Barrie GO Corridor: Upcoming Early Works

What Is Happening

As part of works along the Barrie Line, Metrolinx crews will be conducting a series of early and preparatory work in advance of future improvements to be made along the corridor. These works include clearing and grubbing, tree removals, and the demolition of 2-4 Croham Road (Figure 1) and will approximately take nine weeks in duration to complete.

GO Expansion

More trains, less waiting! GO Expansion will deliver faster, more frequent service across the region. Our goal is to create a network that has the capacity to deliver service every 15 minutes or better, in both directions, all day. Customers won't need to check a train schedule because they'll know that the next one will be along soon.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- **Noise:** Residents and businesses near the rail corridor may hear noise caused by trucks, chainsaws, woodchippers and other construction equipment required for this work.
- **Tree Markings:** You may also see markings on trees along the rail corridor that have been identified for removal.
- **Demolition Work:** Demolition works will result in periodic noise, dust, and vibration, these impacts will be actively monitored.
- There may be some dust and vibration impacts associated with the demolition. Every effort will be made to mitigate impacts to surrounding residents.

HOURS OF WORK

- Regular work hours are scheduled for 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
- No overnight work is currently planned.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Early works will occur primarily along the Barrie corridor, in the highlighted work zone north of Eglinton Avenue West (see Figure 1).

- The demolition will occur at 2-4 Croham Road.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no pedestrian sidewalk closures planned.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are no major traffic impacts anticipated for this block of work.

RESTORATION OF THE TREES

- Trees removed as part of this work will be replaced through a tree restoration program based on the Metrolinx Vegetation Guideline (2022).

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT
