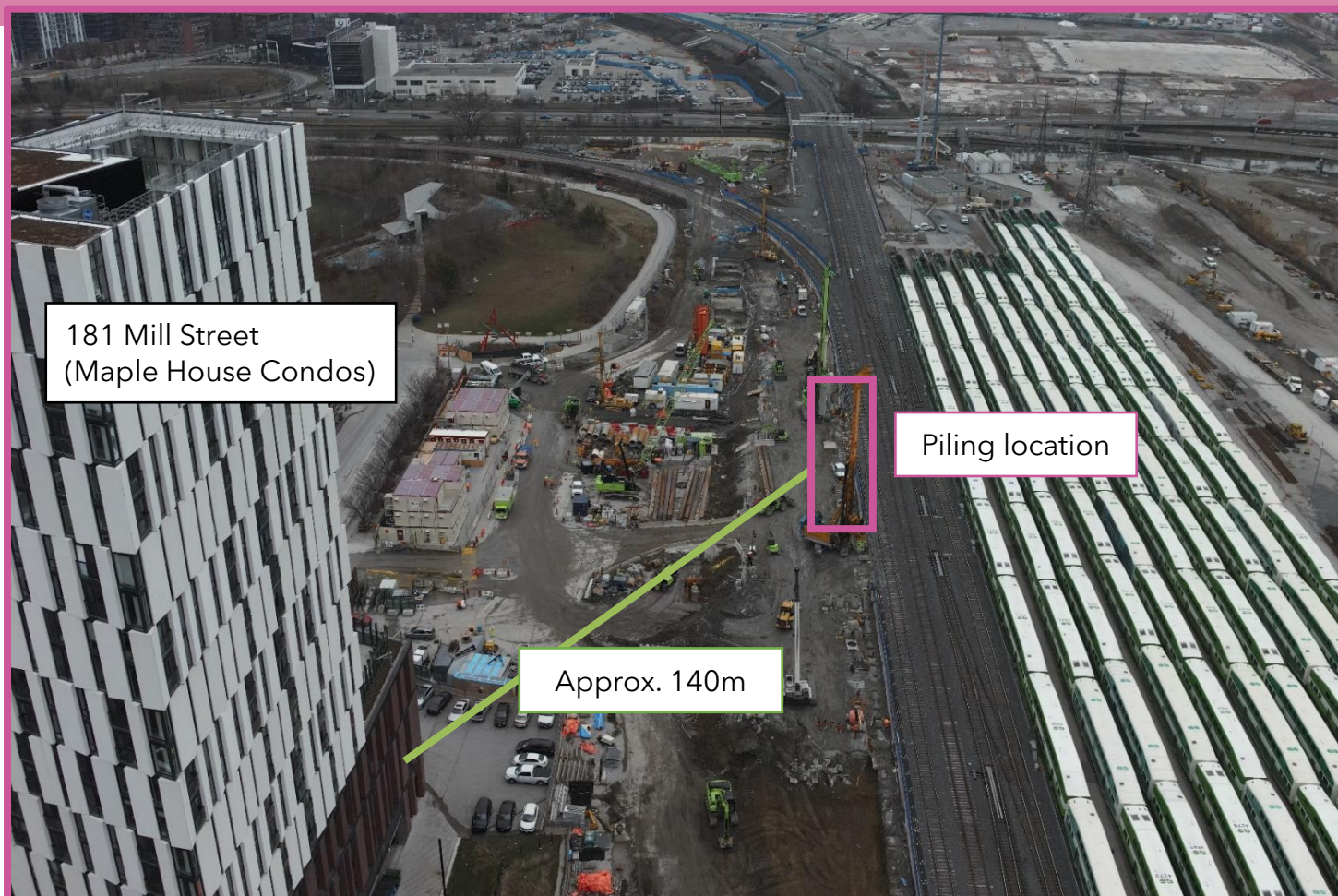


Update: Overnight pile drilling in the Don Yard Rail Corridor

Start date: Week of February 10, 2025

Hours of Work: Monday to Friday between 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.

Duration: Three weeks



What is happening?

- On Monday, February 10, 2025, piling work will begin on the east side of the Don Yard rail corridor, beside live train tracks (see map above)
- Because these piles are located right next to live tracks, they can only be installed safely overnight between 1 a.m. – 5 a.m., during the period when trains are not running
- Approximately 20 piles will be installed in this location - the work will take three weeks to complete
- The piles are located approx. 140m away from Maple House Condos and the work is expected to be less disruptive than the current piling work
- Noise mitigation tools, including the auger cleaner, will remain in place to minimize disruption from the piling work
