
UPDATE: Weekend full closure of Cosburn Avenue west of Pape Avenue

Duration: Friday, February 7 at 6 a.m. to Monday, February 10 at 7 a.m.

What is happening?

- Work for the sewer microtunnelling is progressing to the next stage. During this stage, the team will connect the new sewer to existing infrastructure and extract the microtunnelling machine.
 - This work is expected to be completed over a single weekend.
 - There will be a full closure of Cosburn Avenue from west of the laneway to the crosswalk on the west side of Pape Avenue.
 - The ongoing closure and staging at Gowan Avenue and Pape Avenue will remain.
 - During this weekend closure, the construction team will work continuously to complete the work
- There will be a TTC detour for the 87 Cosburn bus.



What to expect

Construction

- Work will involve the use of large equipment, machines and cranes.
- Residents and businesses in the area may hear noise caused by work equipment. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.




Figure 2: Full closure traffic staging

Traffic and pedestrian details

- Closure schedule:
 - On Thursday, February 6 crews will reduce Cosburn Avenue to two lanes in the vicinity of the laneway (Figure 1), with traffic maintained in each direction.
 - On Friday, February 7 at 6 a.m., the full closure (Figure 2) will begin.
 - On Monday, February 10 at 8 a.m., two lanes on Cosburn Avenue will be reopened, one in each direction (Figure 1).
- During the closure, the sidewalk on the south side of Cosburn Avenue adjacent to the work zone will be closed.
 - Pedestrians travelling eastbound on Cosburn Avenue can access Pape Avenue via the sidewalk on the north side of Cosburn Avenue north of the work zone.
 - Traffic control personnel and paid-duty officers will be on site to ensure pedestrian safety when crossing.
- TTC route 87 Cosburn will detour around the closure area via Pape Avenue, O'Connor Drive, and Broadview Avenue. For more information visit **Updates** at <u>www.ttc.ca/riding-the-ttc</u>.
- Following the closure, the construction crews will reopen Cosburn Avenue.
