Expected start date: As early as February 25, 2025

Duration: 3-5 days

Hours of work: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.



What is happening?

- In preparation for the upcoming Ontario Line elevated guideway construction, crews will drill boreholes within the fenced area above to verify the underlying soil characteristics to inform the design of piers that will support the elevated guideway.
- To allow construction crews work safely onsite, the E.T. Seton Archery Range will be closed during construction and reopened when the work has been completed.



What to expect

- Work is scheduled to start as early as February 25th and take approximately 3-5 days to complete.
- The borehole drilling will primarily occur from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- Ground protection mats will be installed through the archery range to create a path to allow for heavy equipment to move from the roadway to the work zone.
- For the safety of the crews, the archery range will be closed, and all archery activities will be prohibited.
- A paid duty police officer will be onsite when crews are working to ensure the public does not engage in any archery activities.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions or other construction-related impacts.
