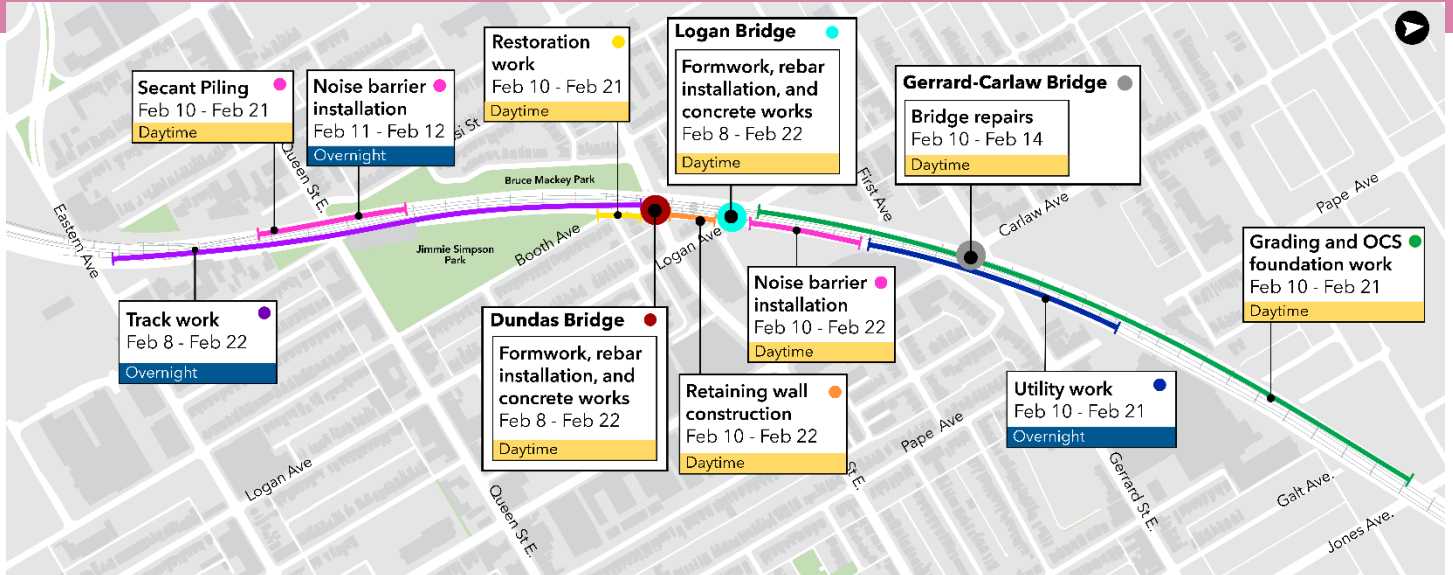


# Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, February 8 to Saturday, February 22, 2025

**Hours of work:**

- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday - Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity - further details below).





**This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.**

**What is happening?**

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. **The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the rail corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from the access road at Eastern Avenue. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

<p>● Saturday February 8 - Saturday February 22, 2025 (weekdays)</p>	<p>Within the rail corridor between Eastern Avenue and Dundas Street</p>	<p><b>Track work</b> Delivering and stockpiling tracks in the rail Corridor, and welding new tracks together.</p>
<p>● Tuesday February 11 - Wednesday February 12, 2025</p>	<p>Within the rail corridor east and west of Queen Street</p>	<p><b>Noise Barrier Installation</b> Installing temporary noise barriers at the top of the rail corridor.</p>
<p>● Monday February 10 - Friday, February 21, 2025 (weekdays)</p>	<p>Within the rail corridor between Thackeray Street and Pape Avenue</p>	<p><b>Utility Work</b> Installing a raceway conduit in the rail corridor.</p>

<p>● Saturday February 8 - Saturday February 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)</p>	<p>Dundas and Logan bridges</p>	<p><b>Formwork, rebar installation, and concrete works</b> <b>Sat Feb 8 to Sun Feb 9:</b> Logan bridge rebar and steel installation.</p>

		
 Monday February 10 - Friday, February 21, 2025 (weekdays)	Booth Ave. and Paisley Ave.	<p><b>Restoration Work</b> Laying topsoil in front of the retaining wall.</p> <p><b>*Sidewalk closure</b> at the north-west corner of Booth-Paisley will be in place as early as Thurs Feb 13 for approx. three weeks to complete retaining wall work.</p> <p>*Residents in nearby properties may feel vibrations during compaction work; noise and vibration monitoring is in place to ensure regulatory limits are maintained.</p>
 Monday February 10 - Friday February 21, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor between Logan Ave. and Jones Ave.	<p><b>Grading work and OCS foundation work</b> Leveling and laying track ballast and granular material. Installing foundations for OCS poles.</p>
 Monday February 10 - Friday February 21, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor north and south of the Queen Street bridge	<p><b>Secant Piling at Queen bridge</b> Drilling piles for the future Riverside-Leslieville Station. A drill rig will be used to complete this work.</p>
 Monday February 10 - Saturday February 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Dundas and Logan bridges	<p><b>Retaining wall construction</b> Placing concrete blocks (T-walls), backfilling and compacting granular material.</p> <p>*Residents in nearby properties may feel vibrations during compaction work; noise and vibration monitoring is in place to ensure regulatory limits are maintained.</p>
 Monday February 10 - Saturday February 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Logan Avenue and Thackeray Street	<p><b>Noise barrier installation</b> Installing noise barrier panels and footings in the rail corridor.</p>
 Monday February 10 - Friday February 14, 2025 (weekdays)	Gerrard and Carlaw bridge	<p><b>Bridge repairs</b> Remedial works (waterproofing and backfilling) on top of the bridge.</p>

## What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Noise from trucks and equipment entering the rail corridor at Eastern Avenue.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implemented to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
