



Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Metrolinx hereby gives notice that submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4(1) of the said Act, Metrolinx has deposited a notification of a minor work, in accordance with the requirements set out on the External Submission Site, on the online Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 12110 a description of the following work:

Construction of a temporary watercourse crossing over the West Branch of the Don River, commonly referred to as the West Don River, in Toronto, Ontario at approximately 43°42'45.71" N and 79°20'26.97" W.
