

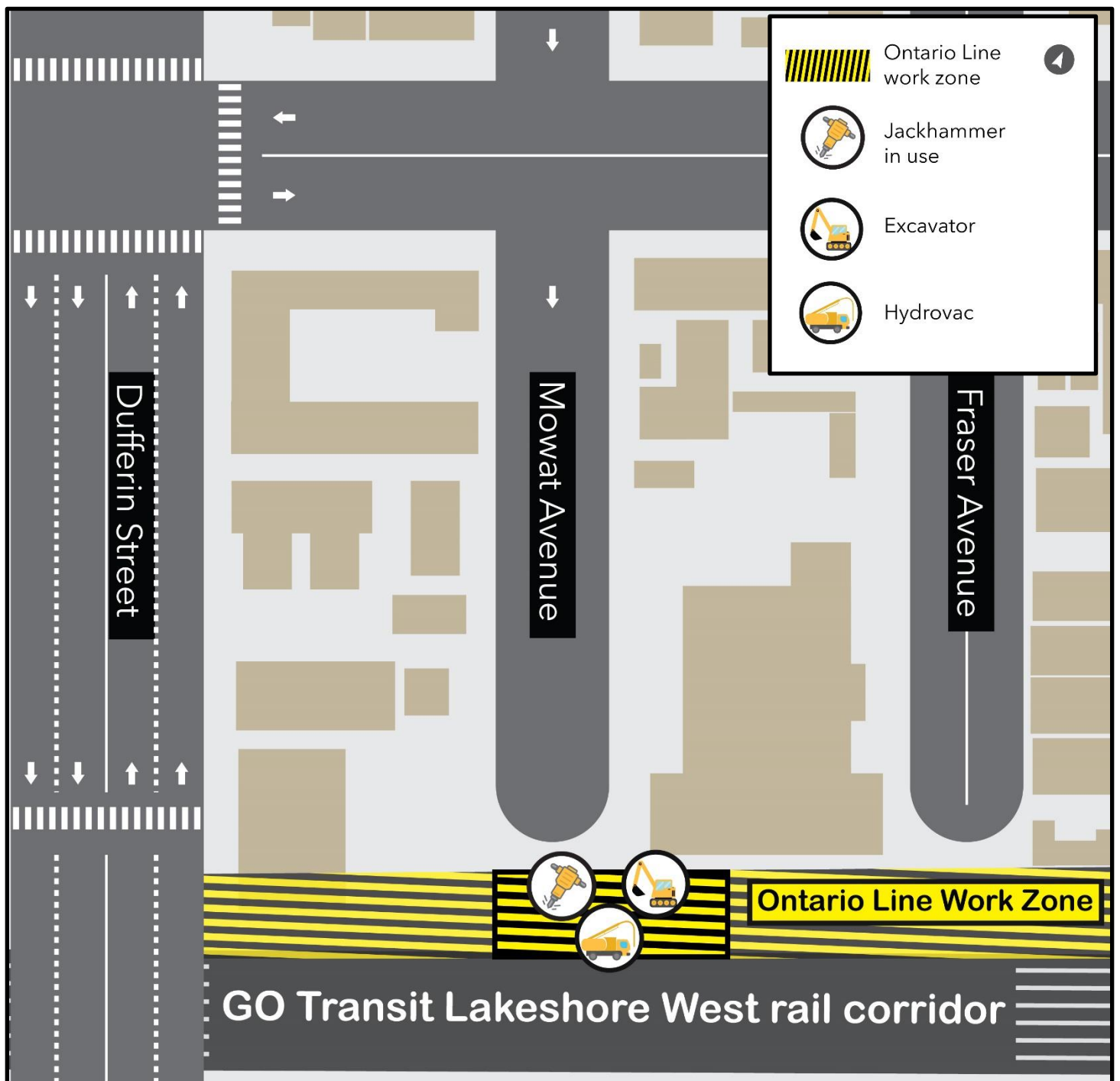
Watermain replacement work south of Mowat Avenue, Fraser Avenue

Expected start date: February 18, 2025.

Duration: Through February 21, 2025.

Hours of work: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- To facilitate construction of the new Ontario Line subway station at Exhibition, crews are installing new portions of watermains within the Ontario Line work site.
- To complete this work, crews will be working at the southern foot of Mowat Avenue, west of Fraser Avenue. Crews will utilize jackhammers for concrete chipping, an excavator and a hydrovac truck.
- No water outages or shut offs are required during this period.

What to expect

- Periodic noise from concrete chipping (jack hammer) and hydrovac work, as crews access and replace watermain infrastructure within the Ontario Line work zone. This sub section of the work zone is indicated by the black border, on the map above.
- Sidewalks and lanes on Mowat Avenue and Fraser Avenue will not be impacted.
- Work will be completed during daytime shifts (7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.). No overnight work is required.
- All necessary permits have been acquired. Work times may shift due to unforeseen circumstances.
