
Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, February 22 to Saturday, March 8, 2025 **Hours of work:**

- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity further details below).



This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.

What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the rail corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from the access road at Eastern Avenue. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.

•	Saturday February 22, 2025 and resuming Wednesday February 26 - Saturday March 8, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Eastern Avenue and Dundas Street	Track work Delivering and stockpiling tracks in the rail Corridor and welding new tracks together.		
•	Monday February 24 - Friday March 7, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor between Thackeray Street and Pape Avenue	Utility Work Installing a raceway conduit in the rail corridor.		
•	Friday February 28 at 7 p.m. until Monday March 3 at 5 a.m.	Queen Street between Degrassi Street and McGee Street	Queen Street East Road Closure Queen Street East will be closed underneath the rail bridge to install bridge girders. The TTC 501 streetcar will be out of service during the road closure. For more information visit www.ttc.ca . *Overnight prep work for the Queen Street East Road Closure will take place on Wed Feb 26 to Thurs Feb 27. Crews will be detaching the streetcar cables from the bridge and performing formwork removals.

•	Saturday February 22 - Saturday March 8, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Dundas and Logan bridges	Formwork, rebar installation, and concrete works Sat Feb 22 & Sun Feb 23: Logan bridge rebar and steel installation.
•	Monday February 24 - Friday, February 28, 2025 (weekdays)	*Sidewalk closure at the north-west corner of Booth-Paisley starting Mon Feb 24 for approx. one week.	Restoration Work and Staircase Installation Performing restoration work in front of the retaining walls and installing a new staircase at 2 Paisley Ave. Mon Feb 24 - Tues Feb 25: Grading and paving at 2 Paisley Ave. to prep for the staircase installation. Compaction work will be required. Residents in nearby properties may feel vibrations. Wed Feb 26 - Fri Feb 28: Delivering and installing a new staircase at 2 Paisley Ave. Use of trucks and construction equipment can be expected.
•	Monday February 24 - Friday February 28, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor between Logan Ave. and Jones Ave.	Grading work, noise barrier installation, and OCS foundation work Leveling and laying track ballast and granular material. Installing foundations for OCS poles. *One day of grading work at Eastern Ave. on Sat Feb 22 to reposition the access road.
•	Monday February 24 - Friday March 7, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor north and south of the Queen Street bridge	Secant Piling at Queen bridge Drilling piles for the future Riverside-Leslieville Station. A drill rig will be used to complete this work.
	Monday February 24 - Friday March 7, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor between Dundas and Logan bridges	Retaining wall and noise barrier construction Placing concrete blocks (T-walls), backfilling and compacting granular material. Installing noise wall posts.
•	Tuesday February 25 - Saturday March 8, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Queen Street East and Dundas Street East	Track work Delivering and stockpiling tracks in the rail Corridor and welding new tracks together.
•	Monday February 24 - Friday February 28, 2025 (weekdays)	Gerrard and Carlaw bridge	Bridge repairs Remedial works (waterproofing and backfilling) on top of the bridge.

What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Noise from trucks and equipment entering the rail corridor at Eastern Avenue.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implanted to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
